Hope: **1.** A wish or desire accompanied by confident expectation of its fulfillment.

2. Something that is hoped for or desired: Success is our hope.

3. One that is a source of or reason for hope: the team's only hope for victory.

4. often **Hope Christianity** The theological virtue defined as the desire and search for a future good, difficult but not impossible to attain with God's help.

Joy: **1. a.** Intense and especially ecstatic or exultant happiness.

b. The expression or manifestation of such feeling.

2. A source or an object of pleasure or satisfaction

Glory: **1.** Great honor, praise, or distinction accorded by common consent; renown.

2. Something conferring honor or renown.

3. A highly praiseworthy asset.

4. Adoration, praise, and thanksgiving offered in worship.
