#### Jacob was destined by God to have the birthright blessing. Genesis 25:23-NLT

**23** And the LORD told her, "The sons in your womb will become *two nations*. From the very beginning, the two nations *will be rivals*. One nation will be stronger than the other; and *your older son will serve your younger son."* 

## Esau concerning his future:

#### Genesis 25:31-33-AMP

31 Jacob answered, Then sell me today your birthright <u>(the rights of a</u> *firstborn*).

32 Esau said, See here, I am at the point of death; *what good can this birthright do me?* 

33 Jacob said, *Swear to me today [that you are selling it to me]; and he swore to [Jacob] and sold him his birthright.* 

a. Giving into deception can bring bondage and lost blessing.

#### Genesis 27:3-4-AMP

3 So now, I pray you, take your weapons, your [*arrows in a*] quiver and your bow, and go out into the open country and hunt game for me,

4 And prepare me appetizing meat, such as I love, and bring it to me, that I may eat of it, [preparatory] to giving you my blessing [as my firstborn] before I die.

**Jacob** – "to seize by the heel"...supplanter...replace, supersede, displace, take over from, substitute for, override; To oust, usurp, overthrow, remove, unseat, dethrone; succeed, come after...

#### Genesis 27:19-AMP

And Jacob said to his father, <u>I am Esau your firstborn</u>; I have done what you told me to do. Now sit up and eat of my game, <u>so that you may proceed to bless me.</u>

#### Genesis 27:28-29-AMP

28 And may God give you of the dew of the heavens and of the fatness of the earth and abundance of grain and [*new*] wine;

29 Let peoples serve you and nations bow down to you; be master over your brothers, and let your mother's sons bow down to you. Let everyone be cursed who curses you and favored with blessings who blesses you.

#### Genesis 27:35-36-AMP

35 [*Isaac*] said, Your brother came with crafty cunning and treacherous deceit and has taken your blessing.

36 [*Esau*] replied, Is he not rightly named Jacob [*the supplanter*]? For he has supplanted me these two times: he took away my birthright, and now he has taken away my blessing! Have you not still a blessing reserved for me?

b. Negative words that have been <u>spoken over</u> us can also be <u>broken off</u> of us by declaring the truth.

#### Proverbs 8:7-NLT

7... for *I speak the truth* and *detest every kind of deception*.

# Esau's destiny is spoken.

Genesis 27:40-NKJV

"And by thy <u>sword shalt thou live</u>, and shalt <u>serve thy brother</u>; and it shall come to pass <u>when thou shalt have the dominion</u>, that <u>thou shalt break his</u> yoke from off thy neck."

BBE - ...By your sword will you get your living and you will be your brother's servant; but <u>when your power is increased</u> his yoke will be broken from off your neck.

#### Isaiah 10:27-AMP

27 ...And it shall be in that day that <u>the burden of [the Assyrian] shall depart</u> <u>from your shoulders</u>, and his yoke from your neck. The yoke shall be destroyed because of fatness [which prevents it from going around your neck]. [Deut. 32:15.]

#### Ephesians 6:17-18-Passion

Embrace the power of salvation's full deliverance, like a helmet <u>to protect</u> your thoughts from lies. And <u>take the mighty Spirit-sword of the spoken</u> Word of God.

c. Satan's <u>power</u> and <u>authority</u> over your life has <u>already been broken</u> by the death and resurrection of Jesus.

# Galatians 5:1-NKJV

**1** Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

#### Genesis 27:41-AMP

41 And *Esau hated Jacob* because of the blessing with which his father blessed him; and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are very near. When [*he is gone*] *I will kill my brother Jacob*.

## Jacob has to meet his brother for the first time in 21 years. Genesis 33:3-4-AMP

3 Then Jacob went over [*the stream*] before them and <u>**bowed himself to the**</u> ground seven times, until he came near to his brother.

4 But *Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him and fell on his neck and kissed him, and they wept.* [*Luke 15:20.*]

#### Genesis 33:9-11-AMP

9 And Esau said, I have plenty, my brother; keep what you have for yourself. 10 But Jacob replied, No, I beg of you, if now I have found favor in your sight, receive my gift that I am presenting; for truly to see your face is to me as if I had seen the face of God, and you have received me favorably.

11 Accept, I beg of you, my blessing and gift that I have brought to you; for God has dealt graciously with me and I have everything. And he kept urging him and *he accepted it*.

d. We need to allow the Holy Spirit to <u>speak to us</u> through <u>the Word</u> of who <u>we really are</u>.

#### Psalm 119:130-Passion

130 ... Break open your Word within me *until revelation-light shines out*!

ESV - ...but when you grow restless you shall break his yoke from your neck."

## Jesus sees how you are feeling right now and He says in: Matthew 11:28-29-KJV

"Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me. For I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light."

**AMP** - ...You will find rest (relief and ease and refreshment and recreation and blessed quiet) for your souls.

Passion – 28-29... "So everyone, come to me! Are you weary, carrying a heavy burden? Then come to me. I will refresh your life, for I am your oasis.
29 Simply join your life with mine. Learn my ways and you'll discover that I'm gentle, humble, easy to please. You will find refreshment and rest in me.
