### Psalm 127:2-AMP

It is vain for you to rise up early, to take rest late, to eat the bread of *[anxious] toil*--for *<u>He gives [blessings] to His beloved in sleep.</u>* 

### 1. STRESS COMES INTO OUR LIVES: WHEN WE <u>FOCUS ON</u>, OR EVEN <u>SPEAK NEGATIVELY ABOUT</u> THE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT WE FACE.

### Matthew 6:25,31-AMP

**25** Therefore I tell you, <u>stop being perpetually uneasy (anxious</u> <u>and worried) about your life</u>, what you shall eat or what you shall drink; or about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life greater [*in quality*] than food, and the body [*far above and more excellent*] than clothing?

31 Therefore, *do not worry and be anxious, saying*, What are we going to have to eat? or, What are we going to have to drink? or, What are we going to have to wear?

### **Philippians 4:6-AMP**

Do not <u>fret or have any anxiety</u> about anything, <u>but</u> in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God.

Passion – 6 <u>Don't be pulled in different directions or worried</u> <u>about a thing</u>. Be <u>saturated in prayer throughout each day</u>, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. <u>Tell him every detail of your life</u>,...

### 2. STRESS LEAVES OUR LIVES: WHEN WE <u>THROW ALL THE</u> <u>CONCERNS</u> ON HIS SHOULDERS.

### 1 Peter 5:7-NKJV

....<u>casting all your care upon Him</u>, for He cares for you.

#### Passion

7 *Pour out all your worries and stress upon him and leave them there*, for he always tenderly cares for you.

His power can begin to operate because you've <u>acted in faith</u> and <u>cast your cares</u> on Him!

# 3. WE HAVE <u>EVERYTHING WE NEED</u> FROM <u>HEAVEN</u> (GOD'S RESOURCES) TO LIVE FREE FROM STRESS.

### **Philippians 4:19-Passion**

19 I am convinced that *my God shall fully satisfy every need you have*, for I have seen *the abundant riches of glory* revealed to me through the Anointed One, Jesus Christ!

### **Ephesians 1:3-GW**

**3** Praise the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! Through Christ, *God <u>has blessed us</u> with every spiritual blessing that heaven has to offer.* 

Passion - 3 <u>Everything heaven contains has already been lavished</u> <u>upon us as a love gift from our wonderful heavenly Father</u>, the Father of our Lord Jesus—<u>all because</u> he sees us wrapped into Christ. This is why we celebrate him with all our hearts!

Blessed – barak - to "be blessed, to kneel, or to be adored." It also means to "be endowed with divine favor, protection, and prosperity."

### Galatians 3:13–14-KJV

Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: that **the blessing** of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith"

Passion – 14 ...Jesus, our Messiah was hung upon a "tree," *bearing the curse in our place* and in so doing, *dissolved it from our lives, so that* <u>all the blessings</u> of Abraham can be poured out upon even non-Jewish believers. Through Christ, you and I have received the blessing of Abraham.

We have been <u>empowered to do well</u>, and we have been <u>endowed with the favor</u> and <u>goodness</u> of God.

You have to <u>replace</u> those worries with the <u>Word</u>. You are the one who has to keep your <u>thoughts under control</u>.

### Luke 8:11,14-GW

11 "This is what the story illustrates: *The seed is God's word.*14 The seeds that were planted among thornbushes are people who hear the word, but as *life goes on the worries, riches, and pleasures of life choke them.* So they don't produce anything good.

### Hebrews 13:5-6-AMP

**5** Let your character or moral disposition be free from love of money [*including greed*, *lust*, *and craving for earthly possessions*] and be satisfied with your present [*circumstances and with what you have*]; for <u>He [God] Himself has said</u>, I will not in any way fail you nor give you up nor leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless nor forsake nor let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not6 So we take comfort and are encouraged and confidently and boldly say, *The Lord is my Helper; I will not be seized with alarm [I will not fear or dread or be terrified]. What can man do to me.*
