BLESSED AND BROKEN...IN MASTER'S HANDS. Sunday, November 26th, 2017 Pastor Audie Clairmont

Matthew 14:16-20-AMP

- **16** Jesus said, <u>They do not need to go away; you give them something to eat.</u>
- 17 They said to Him, We have nothing here but five loaves and two fish.
- 18 He said, Bring them here to Me.
- 19 Then He ordered the crowds to recline on the grass; and He took the five loaves and the two fish, and, looking up to heaven, *He gave thanks and blessed and broke* the loaves and handed the pieces to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people.
- 20 And they all ate and were satisfied. And they picked up twelve [small hand] baskets full of the broken pieces left over.

Ephesians 6:13-AMP

13b...having done all [the crisis demands], to stand [firmly in your place].

God wants you to experience <u>multiplication/inrease</u> in your life.

Genesis 17:2,6-AMP

- **2** And I will make My covenant (solemn pledge) between Me and you and will multiply you exceedingly.
- 6 And <u>I will make you exceedingly fruitful</u> and <u>I will make nations of you</u>, and <u>kings will come from you.</u>
- a. The first key to experiencing divine multiplication or increase is thanksgiving.

Philippians 4:6-AMP

6 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but *in every circumstance and in everything*, by prayer and petition (definite requests), *with thanksqiving*, continue to make your wants known to God.

Passion – 6 ...offering your faith-filled requests before God with *overflowing gratitude*.

b. The second key to experiencing divine multiplication or increase is <u>the blessing.</u>

eulogeō, - "to consecrate a thing with sincere prayers."

Consecrate – to dedicate, devote (commit, give over to).

c. The third key to experiencing divine multiplication or increase was the <u>breaking.</u>

"break" - to separate in pieces. It represents sanctification.

Sanctification – *to set apart for God.*

2Corinthians 9:10-Passion

10 This generous God <u>who supplies abundant seed</u> for the farmer, which becomes bread for our meals, is even more extravagant toward you. First <u>he supplies every need, plus more.</u> Then he <u>multiplies</u> the seed <u>as you</u> sow it, so that the <u>harvest of your generosity will grow.</u>

supplies – ministereth-(greek)-epichoregeo-(ep-ee-khor-ayg-eh'-o) – someone who pays all expenses for, plus providing income for those who take part.
