#### Acts 16:16-26-AMP

- 16 <u>As we were on our way to the place of prayer</u>, we were met by a slave girl who was possessed by a spirit of divination [claiming to foretell future events and to discover hidden knowledge], and she brought her owners much gain by her fortunetelling.
- 17 She kept following Paul and [the rest of] us, shouting loudly, These men are the servants of the Most High God! They announce to you the way of salvation!
- 18 <u>And she did this for many days. Then Paul, being sorely annoyed and worn out,</u> turned and said to the spirit within her, I charge you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her! And it came out that very moment.
- 19 But when her owners discovered that their hope of profit was gone, they caught hold of Paul and Silas and dragged them before the authorities in the forum (marketplace), [where trials are held].
- 20 And when they had brought them before the magistrates, they declared, These fellows are Jews and they are throwing our city into great confusion.
- 21 They encourage the practice of customs which it is unlawful for us Romans to accept or observe!
- 22 The crowd [also] joined in the attack upon them, and the rulers tore the clothes off of them and commanded that they be beaten with rods.
- 23 And when they had struck them with many blows, they threw them into prison, charging the jailer to keep them safely.
- 24 He, having received [so strict a] charge, put them into the inner prison (the dungeon) and fastened their feet in the stocks.
- 25 But about midnight, as Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the [other] prisoners were listening to them,
- 26 Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the very foundations of the prison were shaken; and at once all the doors were opened and everyone's shackles were unfastened.

A spiritual breakthrough is when <u>God intervenes supernaturally</u> on our behalf—when He comes through and <u>manifests Himself</u> in a mighty way in our lives.

# 18 ...then Paul, being sorely annoyed and worn out...

**LITV** - ...And she did this over many days. **But becoming distressed**, and turning to the *demonic* spirit, Paul said, In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out from her! And it came out in that same hour.

**Distressed** - cause anguish to, cause suffering to, upset, make miserable, trouble, worry, bother, agitate.

We live in a world today that wants to wear you down and where you out.

#### 2Peter 2:7-9-AMP

- 7 And He rescued righteous Lot, greatly <u>worn out and distressed by the</u> wanton ways of the ungodly and lawless--[Gen. 19:16, 29.]
- 8 For that just man, <u>living [there] among them</u>, tortured his righteous soul every day with <u>what he saw and heard of [their] unlawful and wicked</u> <u>deeds--</u>
- 9 Now if [all these things are true, then be sure] **the Lord knows how to rescue the godly out of temptations and trials**, ...
- **KJV** ...(For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, **vexed his righteous soul** from **day to day** with **their** unlawful deeds;)...

**vexed** - to tire down with toil, exhaust with labour; to afflict or oppress with evils; to make trouble for; to treat roughly.

# Job 42:10-AMP

**10** And the Lord <u>turned the captivity of Job</u> and <u>restored his fortunes</u>, <u>when he prayed</u> for his friends;...

BBE - And the Lord <u>made up to Job for all his losses</u>, after he had made prayer for his friends...

You have to maintain an <u>attitude of faith and expectancy</u>, and you will position yourself to experience the miraculous.

Verse 25 ... <u>But about midnight</u>, as Paul and Silas <u>were praying and singing</u> <u>hymns of praise to God</u>, and the [other] prisoners were listening to them...

**Verse 26** ...Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the very foundations of the prison were shaken; and at once <u>all the doors were opened and everyone's shackles were unfastened.</u>

#### Joshua 6:16-AMP

And <u>the seventh time</u>, when the <u>priests had blown the trumpets</u>, <u>Joshua</u> said to the people, Shout! For the Lord has given you the city.

### Hebrews 11:30-AMP

<u>Because of faith</u> the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encompassed for seven days [by the Israelites]...

God has given us everything that we need to live over and above the warfare that comes against our soul.

# 2Peter 1:3-Passion

3 <u>Everything we could ever need for life and complete devotionf to God</u> has already been <u>deposited in us by his divine power</u>.

# Psalm 126:4 -AMP
