I Corinthians 9:27-KJV

But ***I keep under my body***, and ***bring it into subjection***: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a ***castaway***.

Castaway – ***adokimos - ad-ok'-ee-mos*** - is taken from “bad metals” and correctly denotes those which

_____ ; that are found to be without character and worthless, and are therefore rejected and cast away.

NKJV - But ***I discipline my body and bring it into subjection***, lest, when I have preached to others, ***I myself should become disqualified***.

Passion - 25 A true athlete will be disciplined in every respect, practicing constant self-control in order to win a laurel wreath that quickly withers. But we run our race to win a victor’s crown that will last forever.

26 For that reason, I don’t run just for exercise or box like one throwing aimless punches,

27 but I train like a champion athlete. ***I subdue my body and get it under my control***, so that after preaching the good news to others I myself won’t be ***disqualified***.

Joshua 14:8-9,14-NKJV

8 Nevertheless my brethren who went up with me made the heart of the people melt, ***but I wholly followed the LORD my God.***

9 So Moses swore on that day, saying, 'Surely the land where your foot has trodden shall be your inheritance and your children's forever, ***because you have wholly followed the LORD my God.'***

14 **Hebron** therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite to this day, ***because he wholly followed the LORD God of Israel.***

A. **He Had To** _____.

Numbers 13:33-NKJB

33 There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and ***we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight.***

B. **Caleb Had To** _____.

Numbers 14:8-9-NKJV

8 If the LORD delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.'

9 Only do not rebel against the LORD, nor fear the people of the land, for they *are* our bread; their protection has departed from them, and the LORD *is* with us. Do not fear them."
