Isaiah 54:17-AMP.

But no weapon that is formed against you shall prosper, and <u>every</u> tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall show to be <u>in the wrong</u>. This [peace, righteousness, security, triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord [those in whom the ideal Servant of the Lord is reproduced]; this is the righteousness or the vindication which they obtain from Me [this is that which I impart to them as their justification], says the Lord.

1Peter 2:23-KJV

23 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed *himself* to him that judgeth righteously:

NLT - He did not retaliate when He was insulted, nor threaten revenge when He suffered. He left His case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly.

Passion – 23 When he was *verbally abused*, he *did not return with an insult*; when he suffered, he would not threaten *retaliation*. Jesus faithfully entrusted himself into the hands of God, who judges righteously.

Ephesians 6:12-NKJV

For <u>we do not wrestle against flesh and blood</u>, but against <u>principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly <u>places.</u></u>

2Corinthians 3:18-AMP

...[because we] <u>continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a</u>
<u>mirror the glory of the Lord,</u> are constantly being transfigured into
His very own image in ever increasing splendor and *from one*

<u>degree of glory to another</u>; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit.

CJB - ... and we are being changed into *His very image*, from one degree of glory to the next, by Adonai the Spirit.
