## 1Corinthians 2:9-10-KJV

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. **But God** hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit...

1. God has a <u>divine plan</u> for each of our lives.

## Isaiah 64:4-AMP

4 <u>For from of old</u> no one has heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen a God besides You, *Who works and shows Himself active on behalf of him who [earnestly] waits for Him.* 

**Prepared –** Greek- Carries the idea of *<u>a readiness</u> or something that has been <u>fully prepared</u>.* 

2. The Holy Spirit wants to make known Gods plan for our lives.

We as God's children need to develop a <u>spiritual sensitivity</u> or <u>learn to recognize the voice</u> of the Holy Spirit.

**Revealed** – *Greek* - *means* <u>to remove the veil</u>, so you can see what is on the other side.

3. God, the Father, wants the Holy Spirit, <u>to show you</u> what's in His Heart...that <u>He so longs to give you</u>.

**Passion** - 9...Things never discovered or heard of before, things beyond our ability to imagine— these are the many things God has in store for all his lovers.

10 **But God now** unveils these profound realities to us by the Spirit. Yes, he has revealed to us **his inmost heart and deepest mysteries through the Holy Spirit, who constantly explores all things.**
