BEING CONSISTENT IN YOUR CONFIDENCE WITH GOD. Sunday, September 30th, Pastor Audie Clairmont

Ephesians 3:12-KJV

12 In whom we have boldness and access <u>with confidence by the</u> <u>faith</u> of him.

Passion – 12 we have boldness through him, and free access as kings before the Father <u>because of our complete confidence in</u> <u>Christ's faithfulness.</u>

Confidence - the feeling or belief that one can rely on someone or something; firm trust.

Proverbs 3:26 - ...Because <u>*God is your confidence*</u> in times of crisis, keeping your heart at rest in every situation.

Ephesians 2:8-9-NKJV

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,
9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

John 15:4-NIV

...No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

There are three critical areas that will shut down our faith, destroy our confidence, cutting off our access to God's power:

<u>Complaining</u>: This is a negative attitude that keeps us from being thankful for all God has done, for what He's doing, and will do.

1Corinthians 10:10-Passion
10 <u>And we must not embrace their ways by complaining</u>
<u>grumbling with discontent</u>, as many of them did, and were killed by the destroyer!

<u>Self-pity</u>: excessive, self-absorbed unhappiness over one's own troubles.

It is simply a poor me attitude.

Hebrews 12:2-GW

<u>We must focus on Jesus</u>, <u>the source and goal of our faith.</u> He saw the joy ahead of him, so he endured death on the cross and <u>ignored the disgrace it brought him</u>. Then he received the highest position in heaven, the one next to the throne of God.

<u>Pride</u>: It takes credit for what God has done and steals His glory. It makes us independent of God, and we can't bear good fruit apart from Christ.

Proverbs 29:23-AMP

A man's pride will bring him low, but he who is of a humble spirit will obtain honor.
