

GOD IS THE RESTORER OF MY LIFE.

Psalm 23:3-AMP

He refreshes and restores my life (my self); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [*uprightness and right standing with Him—not for my earning it, but*] for His name's sake.

John 10:10-AMP

10 **The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy.** I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).

Luke 19:10 –KJV

10 For the Son of man is come **to seek** and **to save** that which **was lost.**

“lost” - *something ruined, wasted, trashed, devastated, or destroyed. It’s also the same greek word used for the “Destroyer”*

“to seek” – depicts *a search so intense that it could be likened to an investigation for something.*

“save” – *sodzo, implies rescue, such as a rescue from a raging sea, rescue from an illness, rescue from immediate danger, and so forth.*

2Corinthians 5:16-17-AMP

16 Consequently, from now on **we estimate and regard no one from a [purely] human point of view [in terms of natural standards of value].** [No] even though we once did estimate Christ from a human viewpoint and as a man, yet now [*we have such knowledge of Him that*] **we know Him no longer [in terms of the flesh].**

17 Therefore if any person is [*ingrafted*] in Christ (the Messiah) **he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!**

Philippians 2:13-AMP

13 [*Not in your own strength*] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [*energizing and creating in you the power and desire*], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight.

Passion – verses 12-13...Continue to allow your new life to manifest through you as you live in the holy awe of God— which brings you trembling into his presence. 13 **God will continually revitalize you,** implanting within you the passion to accomplish the good things you desire to do.
