

THE INTERVENTION OF ANGELS

Hebrews 1:13-14-KJV

But to which of the angels did He at any time say: "Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool"? Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to minister to those who will inherit salvation?

Passion – 13 And God has never said this to any of his angels: "Take your seat next to me at my right hand Until I force your whispering enemies To be a rug under your feet."

14 What role then, do the angels have? The angels are spirit-messengers sent by God to serve those who are going to be saved.

Psalm 33:6-AMP

6 By the word of the Lord were the heavens made, and all their host by the breath of His mouth.

"**breath**" of God's mouth Hebrew word - *ruach*, also translated *Spirit and wind*.

... the sole purpose of their existence is to minister to God above and to human beings below.

Mark 1:13-AMP

13 And He stayed in the wilderness (desert) forty days, being tempted [*all the while*] by Satan; and He was with the wild beasts, and *the angels ministered to Him [continually]*.

Psalm 103:20-21-AMP

20 Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, *you His angels, you mighty ones who do His commandments, hearkening to the voice of His word.*

21 Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, *all you His hosts, you His ministers who do His pleasure.*

Psalm 91:11-12-AMP

11 For He will give His angels [*especial*] *charge over you to accompany and defend and preserve you in all your ways [of obedience and service]*.

12 *They shall bear you up on their hands*, lest you dash your foot against a stone. [*Luke 4:10, 11; Heb. 1:14.*]
