Hebrews 1:13-14-KJV

But to which of the angels did He at any time say: "Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool"? Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to minister to those who will inherit salvation?

Passion – 13 And God has never said this to any of his angels: "Take your seat next to me at my right hand Until I force your whispering enemies To be a rug under your feet."

14 What role then, do the angels have? The angels are spirit-messengers sent by God to serve those who are going to be saved.

Psalm 33:6-AMP

6 By the word of the Lord were the heavens made, and all their host by the breath of His mouth.

"breath" of God's mouth Hebrew word - ruach, also translated <u>Spirit and wind.</u>

... the sole purpose of their existence is **to minister to God** above and **to human beings below.**

Mark 1:13-AMP

13 And He stayed in the wilderness (desert) forty days, being tempted [all the while] by Satan; and He was with the wild beasts, and the angels ministered to Him [continually].

Psalm 103:20-21-AMP

20 Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, <u>you His</u> <u>angels, you mighty ones who do His commandments,</u> <u>hearkening to the voice of His word.</u>

21 Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, <u>all you</u> <u>His hosts, you His ministers who do His pleasure.</u>

Psalm 91:11-12-AMP

- 11 For He will give His angels [especial] charge over you to accompany and defend and preserve you in all your ways [of obedience and service].
- 12 <u>They shall bear you up on their hands</u>, lest you dash your foot against a stone. [Luke 4:10, 11; Heb. 1:14.]
