John 11:43-44-NKJV

- 43 Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"
- 44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with grave clothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."

John 11:3-5-NKJV

- 3 Therefore the sisters sent to Him, saying, "Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick."
- 4 When Jesus heard *that*, He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it."
- 5 Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus.
- 6 So, when He heard that he was sick, He stayed two more days in the place where He was.
- 7 Then after this He said to the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again."

John 11:14-22-NKJV

- 14 Then Jesus said to them plainly, "Lazarus is dead.
- 15 And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, that you may believe. Nevertheless let us go to him."
- 16 Then Thomas, who is called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with Him."
- 17 So when Jesus came, He found that he had already been in the tomb four days.
- 18 Now Bethany was near Jerusalem, about two miles away.
- 19 And many of the Jews had joined the women around Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother.
- 20 Now Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met Him,

but Mary was sitting in the house.

21 Now Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died.

22 But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You."

John 11:23-24-NKJV

- 23 Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."
- 24 Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."
- 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

Instead of congregating around <u>what has been</u>, we should be eager to step into <u>what will be</u> - new life, new opportunities, and new blessings!

Romans 13:12-NKJV

The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us *cast off* the works of darkness, and let us *put on* the armor of light.

Ephesians-4:22-NKJV

22 that you *put off*, concerning your *former conduct*, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,

Colossians-3:8-9-NKJV

But now you yourselves are to *put off all these*: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.

<u>9</u> Do not lie to one another, since you have *put off the old man* with his deeds,

Things we should put on after we have discarded the old: Galatians-3:27-NKJV

27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have <u>put on</u> **Christ.**

Ephesians-4:24-NKJV

24 and that you *put on the new man* which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

Romans 6:4-NKJV

4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Romans 7:6-NKJV

But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should **serve in the newness of the Spirit** and **not in the oldness of the letter**.
