

OFFERING THE SACRIFICE OF THANKSGIVING.

Psalm 100:1-5-NKJV

- 1 Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!
- 2 Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing.
- 3 Know that the LORD, He *is* God; *It is* He *who* has made us, and not we ourselves; *We are* His people and the sheep of His pasture.
- 4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *and* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name.
- 5 For the LORD *is* good; His mercy *is* everlasting, And His truth *endures* to all generations.

Psalm 100-5-Passion

1 Lift up a great shout of joy to the Lord! Go ahead and do it—Everyone, everywhere! 2 As you serve him, be glad and worship him. Sing your way into his presence with joy! 3 And realize what this really means—We have the privilege of worshipping the Lord, our God. For he is our Creator, and now we belong to him! We are the people of his pleasure. 4 You can pass through his open gates With the password of praise. Come right into his presence with thanksgiving. Come bring your thank-offering to him and affectionately bless his beautiful name! 5 For the Lord is always good And ready to receive you. He's so loving that it will amaze you; So kind that it will astound you! And he is famous for his faithfulness toward all. Everyone knows our God can be trusted, for he keeps his promises to every generation!

Praise - Hebrew - *tôḏāh* - derived from *yāḏāh* - "*to confess publicly*," and *expresses the idea of an offering or sacrifice of thanksgiving*.

Leviticus 7:12 KJV

If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the *sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil*, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried.

yāḏāh - '*recognition*' and '*declaring or confessing a fact or truth* about God, ...*praising and giving thanks to God*.

Isaiah 38:19-AMP

19 The living, the living--they shall *thank and praise You*, as I do this day; the father shall make known to the children *Your faithfulness and Your truth*.

Psalm 97:12-AMP

12 *Rejoice in the Lord*, you [*consistently*] righteous (upright and in right standing with God), and *give thanks at the remembrance of His holiness*.

There are at least 8 ways to praise God in Psalm 100.

1. "Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands" (also 98:4).
2. "Serve the Lord with gladness."
3. "Coming before His Presence with singing."
4. "Know ...*yada*...(confess publicly, recognize, get acquainted, experience),... that the LORD, He *is* God,"
5. "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving,"
6. "Enter His courts with Praise."
7. "Be thankful to Him"
8. "bless His name".

Joyful noise - *rûa'* - "to shout."

Thanking Him for being our...*righteousness* - (*yaweh-tsidkenu*),

Thanking Him for His...*sanctification* in our lives (*Yahweh-m-kaddesh*)

Thanking Him for His...*peace* – (*Yahweh-shalom*)

Thanking Him for always...*being there* – (*Yahweh-shammah*)

Thanking Him for being our...*healer* – (*Yahweh-rophe*)

Thinking Him for being our great...*provider* – (*Yahweh-yireh*)

Thank Him for being our...*banner (standard)* – (*Yahweh-nissi*)

Thanking Him for being our...*shepherd* – (*Yahweh-rohi*)

Psalm 26:7-CJB

7 ...*lifting my voice in thanks* and *proclaiming all your wonders*.

Passion - ...*Approaching your altar with songs of thanksgiving; Singing the songs of your mighty miracles*.

YLT - *To sound with a voice of confession*, and *to recount all Thy wonders*.

Psalm 107:22-AMP

22 And let them *sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving* and *rehearse His deeds* with shouts of joy and singing!
