WE NEED TO SERVE, SING, AND PRAISE GOD! March 31st, 2019 Audie Clairmont

Psalm 100:1-5-KJV

1 A Psalm of praise. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

2 Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

3 Know ye that the LORD he *is* God: *it is* he *that* hath made us, and not we ourselves; *we are* his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, *and* into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, *and* bless his name.

5 For the LORD *is* good; his mercy *is* everlasting; and his truth *endureth* to all generations.

Second, "Serve the LORD with gladness" (v. 2).

Serve is ' $\bar{a}\underline{b}a\underline{d}$ - "till" - to portray labor or work on one's own behalf or serving or working for another person.

We can praise God no matter what we are doing.

1 Corinthians. 10:31-KJV

"Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or <u>whatsoever ye do</u>, do all to the glory of God"

Passion - ...31 Whether you eat or drink, *live your life in a way that glorifies and honors God.*

Third, "Come before his presence with singing" (v. 2).

Singing is renānāh - It literally means ... "cry of joy." - "to sing or shout joyfully."

Psalm 63:5-AMP

My whole being shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and **my mouth** shall praise You with joyful lips...(Job 3:7; "Joyful", 20:5, "triumphing")

What do we have to sing about?

• We rejoice in [our] <u>salvation</u>.

Psalm 20:5-NKJV

5 <u>We will rejoice in your salvation</u>, And in the name of our God we will set up *our* banners! May the LORD fulfill all your petitions.

• We sing aloud of [God's] mercy.

Psalm 59:16-NKJV

But I will sing of Your power; Yes, *I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning*;

For You have been my defense And refuge in the day of my trouble.

• We rejoice in His <u>help</u>.

Psalm 63:7KJV

7 Because You have been my help, *Therefore in the shadow of Your wings <u>I will</u> <u>rejoice</u>.*

We sing about His righteous judgment and government.

Psalm 67:4-NKJV

4 Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for joy! For **You shall <u>judge the people</u>** <u>righteously, And govern the nations</u> on earth. Selah

Ephesians 5:18-19-NKJV

18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, *singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,...*

Passion – 18 And don't get drunk with wine, which is rebellion; instead be filled with the fullness of the Holy Spirit. 19 <u>And your hearts will overflow with a</u> <u>joyful song to the Lord Jehovah.</u> Keep speaking to each other with words of Scripture, <u>singing the Psalms with praises and spontaneous songs given by the</u> <u>Spirit!</u>

KJV -...And they *continued stedfastly in the apostles'* <u>doctrine</u> and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

Acts 2:42-44-Passion

42 Every believer was faithfully devoted to following the *teachings* of the apostles. Their hearts were mutually linked to one another, sharing communion and coming together regularly for prayer.

43 A deep sense of holy awe swept over everyone, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders.

44 All the believers were in fellowship as one body, and they shared with one another whatever they had.

Proverbs 29:6-AMP

6 In the transgression of an evil man there is a snare, but the [*uncompromisingly*] righteous man sings and rejoices.

Passion - ...6 The wicked always have a trap laid for others, but the lovers of God escape as they sing and shout in joyous triumph!

Isaiah 24:14-AMP

14 [*But*] these [*who have escaped and remain*] *lift up their voices,* they shout; for the majesty of the Lord they cry aloud from the [*Mediterranean*] Sea.
