## PRAISING GOD BY INCREASING OUR KNOWLEDEGE OF HIM. Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Audie Clairmont

**Psalm 100:1** A Psalm of praise. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

- Psa 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Psa 100:3 *Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is* he *that* hath made us, and not we
- ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
- Psa 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, *and* into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, *and* bless his name.
- Psa 100:5 For the LORD *is* good; his mercy *is* everlasting; and his truth *endureth* to all generations.

Know - yāda' (knowledge acquired by the senses, "to know <u>relationally</u> and <u>experientially.</u>"

GK ginōskō - "to know by experience."

• <u>love and intimacy.</u>

## Matthew 1:25-TLV

**25** But he did not <u>know her intimately</u> until she had given birth to a Son. And he called His name Yeshua.

# Genesis 4:1-AMP

And Adam knew Eve as his wife, and she became pregnant and bore Cain;...

• The <u>personal relationship</u> the believer has with Christ.

# Phillipians 3:10-AMP

**10** [For my determined purpose is] that <u>I may know Him [that I may progressively</u> <u>become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing</u> <u>and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly</u>], and that I may in that same way <u>come to know</u> the power outflowing from His resurrection [which it exerts over believers], and that I may so share His sufferings as to be continually transformed [in spirit into His likeness even] to His death, [in the hope]...

yāda' speaks of <u>God knowing us</u> but also of <u>our knowing Him</u>.

# Genesis 18:19-KJV

**19** <u>For I know him</u>, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

### Deuteronomy 34:10-AMP

**10** And there arose not a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom *the Lord knew face to face,..* 

## John 17:25-AMP

O just and righteous Father, although the world has not known You and has failed to recognize You and has never acknowledged You, *I have <u>known You [continually]</u>; and <u>these men understand and know</u> that You have sent Me.* 

Passion - ...25 "You are my righteous Father, but the *unbelieving world has never known you* in the perfect way <u>that I know you!</u> And <u>all those who believe in me</u> also <u>know</u> that you have sent me!

The psalmist desired to understand and know God's Word.

## Psalm 119:125-AMP

125 I am Your servant; *give me understanding (discernment and comprehension),* that <u>I may know (recognize</u> and <u>be familiar with</u> the character of) Your testimonies. Passion - ...124 ...Let me feel your tender love, for I am yours. *Give me more* understanding of your wonderful ways. <u>125 I need more revelation from your word</u> to know more about you, for I'm in love with you!

Proverbs. 1:2-KJV

To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding...

Proverbs 9:9

"Teach [yāda'] a just man, and he will increase in learning."...

Passion – 9,10...9 *Teach* a wise man what is right and he'll grow even wiser. Instruct the lovers of God and *they'll learn even more*.

10 The starting point for acquiring wisdom is <u>to be consumed with awe as you</u> worship Jehovah God. To receive the revelation of the Holy One, <u>you must come to</u> <u>the one</u> who has living-understanding.

#### 2 Peter. 3:18

"Grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ"

Passion - 18 But continue *to grow and increase in God's grace and <u>intimacy with</u> our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.* 

Psalm 44:21-Passion...declares this about God.

...God, you know our every heart secret. You know we still want you!
