**Appropriate** – *make it your own, take something for your own use.*

### Ephesians 1:3-NKJV

3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing** in the heavenly places in Christ,...

Passion - ...3 **Every spiritual blessing** in the heavenly realm **has already been lavished upon us as a love gift from our wonderful heavenly Father**, the Father of our Lord Jesus—all because he sees us wrapped into Christ. This is why we celebrate him with all our hearts!

### 1Peter 2:24-NKJV

24 who Himself **bore our sins in His own body** on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—**by whose stripes you were healed.**

### Luke 5:23-24-AMP

23 **Which is easier: to say, Your sins are forgiven you, or to say, Arise and walk [about]?**

24 But that you may know that the **Son of Man has the [power of] authority** and right on earth to forgive sins, He said to the paralyzed man, I say to you, arise, pick up your (stretcher), and go to your own house!

**We are healed by Jesus' stripes and the devil is a liar.**

### James 2:26-AMP

26 For as the human body apart from the spirit is lifeless, so **faith apart from [its] works of obedience** is also dead.

### Mark 9:19,22-24-Passion

19 Jesus said to the crowd, **“Why are you such a faithless people? I How much longer must I remain with you and put up with your unbelief?** Now, bring the boy to me.”

22 But please, if you're able to do something, anything—have compassion on us and help us!”

23 Jesus said to him, **“What do you mean ‘if’? If you are able to believe, all things are possible to the believer.”**

24 When he heard this, the boy's father cried out with tears, saying, **“I do believe, Lord; help my little faith!”**

Gk – *“unbelief”*

### Hebrews 6:11-12-Passion

11 But we long to see you **passionately advance until the end and you find your hope fulfilled.**

12 So don't allow your **hearts to grow dull or lose your enthusiasm**, but follow the example of those **who fully received what God has promised because of their strong faith and patient endurance.**

**dull of heart** – means- *to not have a intimate relationship with the Lord that is fervent and passionate.*

KJV – *slothful*

Patience - It means *“to be consistently constant or to be the same way all the time, regardless of what happens.”*

It was always the **people's faith in Jesus** that healed them.

### Matthew 9:28-30-AMP

When He reached the house and went in, the blind men came to Him, and **Jesus said to them, Do you believe that I am able to do this? They said to Him, Yes, Lord.**

29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, **According to your faith and trust and reliance [on the power invested in Me] be it done to you;**

30 **And their eyes were opened...**

### Hebrews 10:23-KJV

23 Let us hold fast the **profession of our faith without wavering;** (for *he is faithful that promised;*)...
