GO OUT AND STAND! Sunday, August 4th, 2019 Audie Clairmont

1Kings 19:9-15-AMP.

- **1Ki 19:9** There he came to a cave and lodged in it; and behold, the word of the Lord came to him, and He said to him, What are you doing here, Elijah?
- 1Ki 19:10 He replied, I have been very jealous for the Lord God of hosts; for the Israelites have forsaken Your covenant, thrown down Your altars, and killed Your prophets with the sword. And I, I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away.
- 1Ki 19:11 And He said, Go out and stand on the mount before the Lord. And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains and broke in pieces the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake;
- 1Ki 19:12 And after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire; and after the fire [a sound of gentle stillness and] a still, small voice.
- 1Ki 19:13 When Elijah heard the voice, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood in the entrance of the cave. And behold, there came a voice to him and said, What are you doing here, Elijah?
- 1Ki 19:14 He said, I have been very jealous for the Lord God of hosts, because the Israelites have forsaken Your covenant, thrown down Your altars, and slain Your prophets with the sword. And I, I only, am left, and they seek my life, to destroy it.
- 1Ki 19:15 And the Lord said to him, Go, return on your way to the Wilderness of Damascus; and when you arrive, anoint Hazael to be king over Syria.

Just like David, we need to run toward and face the giant in our lives.

1Samual 17:48-TLV

Then when the Philistine rose and began to advance, drawing near to meet David, David *ran quickly toward* the battle line to meet the Philistine.

Verses - 11 And He said, **Go out and stand on the mount before the Lord**. And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains and broke in pieces the rocks before the Lord, **but the Lord was not in the wind**; and after the wind an earthquake, **but the Lord was not in the earthquake**;

12 And after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire;...

James 5:16-AMP.

16 Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].

James 5:17-18-AMP.

17 Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it not to rain, and no rain fell on the earth for three years and six months. [I Kings 17:1.]

18 And [then] he prayed again and the heavens supplied rain and the land produced its crops [as usual]. [I Kings 18:42-45.]

Verse - 12...and after the fire [a sound of gentle stillness and] a still, small voice...

God said He would never leave us, or forsake us in our time of need.

Hebrews 4:15-16-AMP.

- **15** For we do not have a High Priest Who is <u>unable to understand and sympathize</u> <u>and have a shared feeling with our weaknesses and infirmities and liability to the</u> <u>assaults of temptation</u>, but One Who has been tempted in every respect as we are, yet without sinning.
- 16 <u>Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near</u> to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and <u>find grace to help in good time for every need</u> [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].

Hebrews 13:5-6-AMP.

- ...for He [God] Himself has said, <u>I will not in any way fail you nor give you up nor leave you without support.</u> [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless nor forsake nor let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!]
- 6 So we take comfort and are encouraged and confidently and boldly say,
 The Lord is my Helper; I will not be seized with alarm [I will not fear or dread or be terrified]. What can man do to me?

Jeremiah 29:11-13-AMP

- 11 For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, **thoughts and** plans for welfare and peace and <u>not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.</u>
- 12 Then you will call upon Me, and you will come and pray to Me, <u>and I will hear and</u> heed you.
- 13 Then you will seek Me, inquire for, and require Me *[as a vital necessity] and find Me* when you search for Me with all your heart.
