FROM THE DARKNESS OF THE PIT...TO THE PRAISE OF OUR GOD.

(Prisoners of Hope) Sunday, September 29th, 2019 Audie Clairmont

Zechariah 9:11-12-AMP

As for you also, because of and for the sake of the [covenant of the Lord with His people, which was sealed with sprinkled] covenant blood, I have released and sent forth your imprisoned people out of the waterless pit.

12 Return to the stronghold [of security and prosperity], you **prisoners of hope**; even today do I declare that I will restore double your former prosperity to you.

The "pit" represents the darkest day of your life.

Psalm 88:4-NKJV

4 I am counted with those who go down to the pit; *I am like a man who has no strength...*

Psalm 30:3-NKJV

3 O LORD, <u>You brought my soul up</u> from the grave; <u>You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.</u>

Isaiah 38:17-KJV

17 You have in love **delivered my soul from the pit of corruption...**

Isaiah 38:18

18 For Sheol cannot thank You, Death cannot praise You; <u>Those who go down to</u> the pit cannot hope for Your truth.

Job 33:29-30-AMP

- 29...Behold, God does all these things twice, yes, three times, with a man,
- 30 <u>To bring back his life from the pit [of destruction], that he may be</u> enlightened with the light of the living.

Genesis 37:23-24-NKJV

- **23** So it came to pass, when Joseph had come to his brothers, that they stripped Joseph *of* his tunic, the tunic of *many* colors that *was* on him.
- 24 <u>Then they took him and cast him into a pit. And the pit was empty; there was no water in it.</u>

Shechem – back, shoulder: a place of burdens, to carry a burden.

If we hope in the Lord:

Romans 5: 3-5-AMP

- 3 Moreover [let us also be full of joy now!] <u>let us exult and triumph in our troubles and rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that pressure and affliction and hardship produce patient and unswerving endurance.</u>
- 4 And endurance (fortitude) develops maturity of character (approved faith and tried integrity). And character [of this sort] produces [the habit of] <u>joyful and</u> confident hope of eternal salvation.
- **5** <u>Such hope never disappoints or deludes or shames us,</u> for God's love has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit Who has been given to us.
- KJV "hope maketh not ashamed," which means that we will not be disappointed for our hope in the Lord.

Passion – 3 But that's not all! Even in times of trouble we have a joyful confidence, knowing that our pressures will develop in us patient endurance.

4 And patient endurance will refine our character, and proven character leads us back to hope.

5 And this hope is not a disappointing fantasy, <u>because we can now experience</u> the endless love of God cascading into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who lives in us!

Jeremiah 31:15-17

- 15 Thus says the LORD: "A voice was heard in Ramah, Lamentation *and* bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, Refusing to be comforted for her children, Because they *are* no more."
- 16 Thus says the LORD: "Refrain your voice from weeping, And your eyes from tears; *For your work shall be rewarded, says the LORD*, And they shall come back from the land of the enemy.
- 17 <u>There is hope in your future</u>, says the LORD, That *your* children shall come back to their own border.

Psalm 40:2-3-Passon

- 2. <u>He stooped down to lift me out of danger from the desolate pit I was in, out of the muddy mess I had fallen into.</u> Now he's lifted me up into a firm, secure place and steadied me while I walk along his ascending path.
- 3 A new song for a new day rises up in me every time I think about how he breaks through for me! Ecstatic praise pours out of my mouth until everyone hears how God has set me free.
