We have a mission and mandate from God!

Micah 2:13--AMP

The Breaker [the Messiah] will go up before them. They will break through, pass in through the gate and go out through it, and their King will pass on before them, the Lord at their head.

1. WE ARE TO BE A GENERATION OF DETERMINED BELIEVERS WHO REFUSE TO BE DENIED WHAT IS OURS BY COVENANT RIGHT AND RESPONSIBILITY.

2Corinthians 2:14--15--AMP

But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ's victory]...

2. WE ARE TO BE A GENERATION THAT WILL BRING AN INCREASED PRESENCE AND MANIFESTATION OF HIS KINGDOM.

2Corinthians 2:14--15--AMP

.... and through us spreads and makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere, For we are the sweet fragrance of Christ [which exhales] unto God, [discernible alike] among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

What will we as this generation do?

Isaiah 9:6--7--AMP

For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father [of Eternity], Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and of peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from the [latter] time forth, even forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

Matthew 6:10--Amp

10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Hebrews 12:28--AMP

... Let us therefore, receiving a kingdom that is firm and stable and cannot be shaken, offer to God pleasing service and acceptable worship, ... Passion - ... 28 Since we are receiving our rights as to an unshakeable kingdom we should be extremely thankful and offer God the purest worship that delights his heart as we lay down our lives in absolute surrender, filled with awe.

Romans 1:11-12 Passion... I yearn to come and be face-to-face with you and get to know you. For I long to impart to you the gift of the Spirit that will empower you to stand strong in your faith.

Judges 2:7-12-AMP

And the people served the Lord all the days of Joshua and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the Lord which He did for Israel.

And Joshua son of Nun, the servant of the Lord, died, being 110 years old.

And they buried him within the boundary of his inheritance in Timnath---heres in the hill country of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash.
