Mark 10:46-52-NKJV

Mar 10:46 Now they came to Jericho. As He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great multitude, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the road begging.

Mar 10:47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

Mar 10:48 Then many warned him to be quiet; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

Mar 10:49 So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be called. Then they called the blind man, saying to him, "Be of good cheer. Rise, He is calling you."

Mar 10:50 And throwing aside his garment, he rose and came to Jesus.

Mar 10:51 So Jesus answered and said to him, "What do you want Me to do for you?" The blind man said to Him, "Rabboni, that I may receive my sight."

Mar 10:52 Then Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road.

Verse -46-Passion... they met a **blind beggar** sitting on the side of the road named Timai, the son of Timai

1. WE ARE HIGHLY PRIZED IN THE EYES OF JESUS FOR HIS SALVATION.

Timai - Aramaic - means "**highly prized**" (or "**esteemed**").

Verse-47-AMP ... *Jesus, Son of David, have pity and mercy on me [now]!*

Verse-48-LITV ... *And many warned him that he be quiet. But he much more cried out, Son of David, have mercy on me!*

2. PRAY UNTIL YOU RECIEVE, NO MATTER WHAT THE CONDITIONS ARE AROUND YOU.

Mercy – Hebrew-**chesed** with the common Greek word **eleos**, which speaks of "**kindness or good will towards the miserable and afflicted, joined with a desire to relieve them.**"

Isaiah 35:5, ...Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

Luke 4:18-AMP

The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [*the Anointed One, the Messiah*] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and **recovery of sight to the blind**, to send forth as delivered those **who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity],...**

Psalms 34:6-NKJV

This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard *him*, And saved him out of all his troubles.

3. BE SPECIFIC IN WHAT YOU ARE SEEKING GOD TO DO FOR YOU.

James 4:3-CJB

Or you pray and don't receive, because **you pray with the wrong motive (Incorrectly, Improper), that of wanting to indulge your own desires.**

2 Corinthians 5:17-KJV

Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Luke tells the same story:

Luke 18:42-43-NKJV

Then Jesus said to him, "**Receive your sight; your faith has made you well.**"

43 And immediately he received his sight, and **followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.**
