#### 1Corinthians 15:58-KJV

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord...."

1. WE ARE TO BE A PEOPLE THAT ARE <u>NOT MOVED</u> TO WHAT GOD HAS CALLED US <u>TO BE</u> OR <u>DO FOR HIM</u>.

**Steadfast** - It means to <u>be stationary</u>, such as **something that sits** in one place for a long, long time.

It describes something that is <u>firm and steady</u>. (loyal, faithful, committed, devoted, dedicated, dependable, reliable, steady, true, constant, staunch, solid, trusty.)

#### Hebrews 3:6 - Passion

...And now we are part of his family if we <u>continue courageously to</u> <u>hold firmly</u> to our <u>bold confidence</u> and our <u>victorious hope</u>.

#### Psalm 108:1-AMP

O GOD, my heart is fixed (steadfast, in the confidence of faith)...

2. WE ARE TO BE A PEOPLE THAT <u>EXISTS</u> OR <u>ENDURES</u> OVER A LONG PERIOD OF TIME...NO MATTER WHAT WE FACE.

The word, "unmovable," It means: To not be moved from your place or position. To be "firmly persistent."

#### 1Thessalonians 3:2-3-BBE

We sent Timothy, our brother and God's servant in the good news of Christ, to *give you strength and comfort in your faith;* 3 So that no man might *be moved by these troubles*;...

## 3. WE ARE TO BE A PEOPLE THAT ARE <u>NOT BEING WEARIED</u> BUT, HAVE AN <u>ABUNDANT</u> SUPPLY FROM GOD IN DOING HIS WORK.

"always abounding" in the work of the Lord....

**Abounding** – being great, overflowing, <u>not limited</u>, having <u>abundance</u>...in doing God's work.

What 1 Corinthians 15:58 is really saying to us is:
"...Be reliable; dependable; not easily excited, shaken, or
affected...but always overflowing, and having no limits put on
you... in doing God's work"

### 1Timothy 3:15-AMP

If I am detained, you may know how people ought to conduct themselves in the household of God, which is <u>the church</u> of the living God, <u>the pillar and stay (the prop and support)</u> of the Truth.

**Passion** - ... the church of the living God, His very household and *the supporting pillar and firm foundation of the truth*.
