GOD IS GIVING YOU THE BREAKTHROUGH. Sunday, May 24th, 2020 Pastor Audie D. Clairmont

1Chronicles 14:8-12-AMP

- 8 And when the Philistines heard that David was anointed king over all Israel, [they] all went up to seek David. And [he] heard of it and went out before them.
- 9 Now the Philistines had come and made a raid in the Valley of Rephaim.
- 10 <u>David asked God</u>, Shall I go up against the Philistines? And will You deliver them into my hand? And the Lord said, Go up, and I will deliver them into your hand.
- 11 So [Israel] came up to <u>Baal-perazim</u>, and David smote [the Philistines] there.
 Then David said, <u>God has broken my enemies by my hand, like the bursting</u>
 <u>forth of waters.</u> Therefore they called the name of that place <u>Baal-perazim</u>
 [Lord of breaking through].
- 12 [The Philistines] left their gods there; David commanded and they were burned.

1Peter 5:8-NLT

- 8 <u>Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy,</u> the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, <u>looking for someone to devour.</u>
- **9** <u>Withstand him; be firm in faith</u> [against his onset--rooted, established, strong, immovable, and determined],...

Baal-perazim – *The valley of divisions,...* because the enemies were dispersed there like waters. *a place of breaches; possessor of breaches.*

Jewish Bible – 1Chron. 14:11 ... 'God hath broken mine enemies by my hand, <u>like</u> the breach of waters.'

Breach - make a gap in and break through (a wall, barrier, or defense): the river breached its bank.

Isaiah 43:19-AMP

19 <u>Behold, I am doing a new thing!</u> Now it springs forth; do you not perceive and know it and will you not give heed to it? <u>I will even make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.</u>

In order to get a breakthrough in your life you must do what David did:

1. HE REMINDED HIMSELF OF WHO HE WAS!

1Chron, 14:2-NLT

2 So <u>David knew that the LORD had established him as king over Israel</u>, for his kingdom was highly exalted for the sake of His people Israel.

Hebrews 2:7-AMP

For <u>some little time</u> You have ranked him lower than and inferior to the angels; <u>You have crowned him with glory and honor</u> and set him over the works of Your hands, [Ps. 8:4-6.]

TEV - ... You gave him the glory and honor that belong to a king,...

1Peter 5:10-NLT

10 In His kindness <u>God called you to share in His eternal glory by means of</u> <u>Christ Jesus.</u> So after you have suffered a little while, <u>He will restore, support,</u> and strengthen you, and He will place you on a firm foundation.

Romans 8:37-CJB

37 No, in all these things <u>we are superconquerors</u>, <u>through the One</u> who has loved us.

2. HE ASKED THE LORD WHAT HE SHOULD DO.

1 Chron. - 14:2-AMP...David asked God, Shall I go up against the Philistines?

God does NOT RESPOND TO YOUR NEED, HE RESPONDS TO YOUR OBEDIENCE.

1Samuel 15:22-AMP

15 Samuel said, Has the Lord as great a delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in *obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice,...*

3. HE GAVE GOD THE CREDIT FOR WHAT GOD DID FOR HIM!

1Chron.14: 11-AMP ...David said, ...<u>God has broken my enemies by my hand, like the bursting forth of waters.</u>

Sometimes God will do it *for you*, other times He will do it *through you*.

Romans 4:20-GNB

20 His faith did not leave him, and he did not doubt God's promise; his faith filled him with power, and he gave praise to God.

Psalm 50:23-NLT

23 But <u>giving thanks</u> is a sacrifice that truly honors Me. If you keep to My path, I will reveal to you the salvation of God."
