Joshua 1:2-6-TNIV.

- 2 "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites.
- 3 I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.
- 4 Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west.
- 5 No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.
- 6 Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

1. GOD WANTS YOU TO STEP INTO YOUR POSITION OF AUTHORITY IN HIM!

a. When his time came to lead, Joshua was ready.

1Peter 5:5-6-NIV

- 5 In the same way, you younger men must accept the authority of the elders. And *all of you, serve each other in humility,* for "God opposes the proud but favors the humble."
- **6** So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and <u>at the right time He</u> <u>will lift you up in honor.</u>
- b. Joshua went further than his mentor (Moses) did.

John 14:12-NLT

12 "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in Me <u>will do the same works I have</u> <u>done, and even greater works,</u> because I am going to be with the Father.

Ephesians 4:11-12-NLT

- 11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers.
- **12** Their responsibility is <u>to equip God's people to do His work</u> and <u>build up the church, the body of Christ.</u>
- **GW** ... Their purpose is <u>to prepare God's people, to serve</u>, and <u>to build up</u> the body of Christ.
- 2. GOD WANT'S YOU TO STEP OUT <u>IN FAITH (TRUST)</u> AND <u>CLAIM</u> WHAT HE HAS ALREADY GIVEN YOU!

a. I will give you every place where you set your foot. - Verse- 3

Hebrews 6:11-12-GNB

- 11 Our great desire is that each of you *keep up your eagerness to the end*, <u>so that</u> the things you hope for will come true.
- 12 We do not want you to become lazy, <u>but to be like those who believe and are</u> <u>patient</u>, and <u>so receive what God has promised</u>.
- b. No one will be able to stand up against you all the days of your life. Verse -5

2Chronicles 16:9-AMP

- **9** For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth <u>to show</u> <u>Himself strong in behalf of those</u> whose hearts are blameless toward Him.
- c. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you. Verse-5

Philippians 4:6-AMP

6 <u>Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything</u>, but <u>in every circumstance</u> and <u>in everything</u>, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God.

Joshua 23:14-NLT

- 14 "Soon I will die, going the way of everything on earth. Deep in your hearts <u>you</u> <u>know that every promise of the LORD your God has come true. Not a single one has failed!</u>
- 3. LET THE LORD BE THE STRONGHOLD OF YOUR LIFE!
- a. Be strong and courageous. Verse- 6

Psalm 27:1-ESV

- ...The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the **stronghold of my life**; of whom shall I be afraid?
- b. I will never leave you nor forsake you. Verse- 5b

Joshua 21:43-45-NLT

- **43** So the LORD gave to Israel all the land He had sworn to give their ancestors, and they took possession of it and settled there.
- 44 And the LORD gave them rest on every side, just as He had solemnly promised their ancestors. None of their enemies could stand against them, *for the LORD helped them* conquer all their enemies.
- 45 Not a single one of all the good promises the LORD had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything He had spoken came true.
