# SUPERNATURAL JOY IN THE MIDST OF TRIALS. Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Pastor Audie Clairmont

## James 1:2-4 - Passion

- 2 My fellow believers, when it seems as though you are facing nothing but difficulties see it as an invaluable opportunity to experience the greatest joy that you can!
- 3 For you know that when your faith is tested it stirs up power within you to endure all things.
- 4 And then as your endurance grows even stronger it will release perfection into every part of your being until there is nothing missing and nothing lacking.

**1.** When your facing hard times, allow the <u>supernatural Joy</u> that only the <u>Holy Spirit</u> can give you, to flow through you.

James 1 says in verse 2 – "...My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,..."

**Passion Translation** - My fellow believers, when it seems as <u>though you are</u> <u>facing nothing but difficulties</u> see it as an invaluable opportunity to experience all the joy that you can!

## 1 Thessalonians 1:6-Wuest

And as for you, you became imitators of us and of the Lord, having welcomed the Word *while <u>under much pressure of affliction</u> which was accompanied by joy that <u>had its source in the Holy Spirit,...</u>* 

MJLT - ... Having received the Word in much oppression, with joy of the Holy Spirit...

# 2 Corinthians 8:2-Passion

2 For even during a season of severe difficulty and tremendous suffering, <u>they</u> <u>became even more filled with joy.</u> From the depths of their extreme poverty, <u>super-abundant joy overflowed</u> into an act of extravagant generosity.

## Nehemiah 8:10-AMP

10 ...And be not grieved and depressed, for <u>the joy of the Lord is your strength and</u> <u>stronghold.</u>

Joy - khar-ah...*chara,* derived from the word Khar-is...*charis,* which is the Greek word for *grace.* 

2. Faith tested and passed produces patience to face other trials and tests.

James 1 says in verse 3 ... knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

# **Passion** – 3 For you know that when your *faith is tested* it *stirs up power within you to endure all things.*

**Patience** - to remain in one's spot; to keep a position; or to resolve to maintain some territory that has been gained. It is the state of mind that says, "This is my spot, and I'm not moving!"

**<u>Endurance</u>** - staying power, hang-in-there power, determination.

## Hebrews 12:2-Passion

2 We look away from the natural realm and we fasten our gaze onto Jesus who birthed faith within us and who leads us forward into faith's perfection. His example is this: Because his heart was filled with the joy of knowing that you would be his, <u>he endured</u> the agony of the cross and conquered its humiliation, and now sits exalted at the right hand of the throne of God!

3 So consider carefully how Jesus faced such intense opposition from sinners who opposed their own souls, <u>so that you won't become worn down and cave in under</u> *life's pressures, forgetting your destiny.* 

3. Allowing endurance/patience to grow makes us stronger and more mature for facing every opposition.

**James 1 says in verse 4** – ...But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

**Passion** – 4 And then *as your <u>endurance grows</u> even stronger it will <u>release</u> <u>perfection</u> into every part of your being until there is nothing missing and nothing lacking.* 

## Psalm 51:12-Passion

Let my passion for life be restored, <u>*Tasting joy</u>* in every breakthrough you bring to me.</u>

## Romans 8:28-NKJV

And we know that *all things work together for good to those who love God*, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

Passion – 28 So we are convinced that <u>every detail of our lives is continually woven</u> <u>together to fit into God's perfect plan of bringing good into our lives</u>, for we are his lovers who have been called <u>to fulfill his designed purpose</u>.

## Romans 8:31 – Passion

*If God has determined to stand with us*, tell me, who then could ever stand against us?

Finding joy in God's presence: Psalm 16:11 - ...in Your presence is fullness of joy...
