

### NUMBERS 6:24–26

*The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you, and be gracious unto you; the LORD lift His countenance upon you, and give you peace.*

One encounter with the one true God can change the total direction of our lives!

### NUMBERS 6:27

They (*High Priest*) will put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them.

The Hebrew word El Shaddai - dai means “to shed forth, to pour out, or to heap benefits.”

### JOHN 14:16–17

I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Counselor, that He may be with you forever: the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, for it does not see Him, neither does it know Him. But you know Him, for He lives with you, and will be in you.

### EZEKIEL 36:25–27

Then I will sprinkle clean water upon you, and you shall be clean. From all your filthiness and from all your idols, I will cleanse you. Also, *I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit [a new nature] I will put within you*. And I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh. *I will put My Spirit [Holy Spirit] within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them*.

### What is the glory?

### EXODUS 24:15–17

Moses went up to the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. The glory of the LORD rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days. And on the seventh day He called to

Moses from the midst of the cloud. Now the appearance of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain to the eyes of the children of Israel.

### EXODUS 40:34–35

Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. Moses was not able to enter into the tent of meeting because the cloud settled on it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

### 2 CHRONICLES 5:13–14

The house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud. And the priests were not able to stand in order to serve because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of [God].

### EXODUS 33:18

Then Moses said, “*I pray, show me Your glory*.”

### EXODUS 33:19–20

Then [God] said, “*I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you*. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.” He said, “You cannot see My face, for no man can see Me and live.”

The glory is a person—the person of the one true God, the heavenly Father.

### EXODUS 34:29–30

So when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, amazingly, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him.

### Jesus on the Mount of Transfiguration.

#### Matthew 17:1–2

After six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother and brought them up to a high mountain alone, *and was transfigured before them. His face shone as the sun, and His garments became white as the light.*

#### Matthew 17:3–5

“Lord, it is good for us to be here. If You wish, let us make three tabernacles here: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” While he was still speaking, *suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, “This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased. Listen to Him.”*

#### 1 Timothy 2:5

There is one [God] and one mediator between [God] and men, the Man [the Messiah Yeshua] Christ Jesus.

### Jesus proceeded to proclaim a blessing over them.

#### Luke 24:50–53

Then He led them out as far as Bethany, and *He lifted up His hands and blessed them.* While He blessed them, He parted from them and was carried up into heaven. Then they worshipped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple, praising and blessing [God]. Amen.
