THE PRAYER OF BLESSING-PT 5-OUTLINE

(The Hebrew Word for "Face") September 27th, 2020 Pastor Audie Clairmont

NUMBERS 6:24-26

The LORD bless you *and keep you*; the LORD make His <u>face</u> to shine upon you, and be gracious unto you; the LORD lift His countenance upon you, and give you peace.

Face - Panim – plural form for - "entire being"- It implies "more than one face." (facial expression) Panim comes from the root panah, which means "to turn." His Face – Panahv

God is a person with emotions.

God (our Heavenly Father) gets angry.

1Kings 11:9-10-NKJV

9 So <u>the LORD became anary</u> with Solomon, because his heart had turned from the LORD God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice,

10 and had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods; but he did not keep what the LORD had commanded.

God (our Heavenly Father) has wrath.

Romans 1:18-NKJV

For the *wrath of God* is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,...

God (our Heavenly Father) takes pleasure in people and things.

Psalm 149:4

For the LORD takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the meek with salvation.

God (our Heavenly Father) gets sad and grieves.

Genesis 6:5-6

The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was continually only evil. The LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and *it arieved Him in His heart*.

God (our Heavenly Father) has pity.

Psalm 103:13-NKJV

As a father *pities his children*, so the LORD pities those who fear him.

God (our Heavenly Father) has compassion.

Psalm 145:8-NKJV

The LORD is gracious and *full of compassion*, slow to anger, and great in mercy.

God (our Heavenly Father) can be jealous.

Deuteronomy 5:9

You shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, <u>the LORD your God, am a jealous</u> <u>God</u>,...

God desires a two-way relationship!

Luke 10:27-AMP

And he replied, You must love the Lord your God with <u>all your heart</u> and with all <u>your soul</u> and with <u>all your strenath</u> and with <u>all your mind</u>; [your entire being]

Psalm 27:8

When You said, "Seek My Face," my heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek."

It's a picture of Him still keeping His hands upon your shoulders, but He pulls away so you can now see Him *face-to-face*.

The Lord Bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine upon you...

True intimacy comes when we can see another person face-to-face. When we look into the eyes of another, we can see their <u>expression</u>.

King David valued this type of intimacy with YHWH.

Psalm 102:2

Do not <u>hide Your face from me</u> in the day when I am in trouble; incline Your ear to me; in the day when I call answer me quickly.

Genesis 32:30

Jacob called the name of the place *Peniel*, saying, "I have seen [God] face to face, and my life has been preserved."

Luke7:36-47-On Screen (Open in your bible)

Now the most important point of this account is related to seeing God face-to-face.

Jesus turned to the woman and addressed her face-to-face. She looked into the eyes of Jesus as He talked directly to her for the first time.

Luke 7:48

Then He said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."

The **LORD bless you** *and keep you*; the LORD make His <u>face</u>...

But the Hebrew translation is:

May YaHWeH (the Self-Existent Eternal One) kneel before you (making Himself available to you as your heavenly Father) so He can grant, or bestow upon you His promises and gifts! May YHWH (YaHWeH, your heavenly Father) guard you with a hedge of thorny protection that will prevent Satan and all your enemies from harming you. May He protect your body, soul, mind, and spirit, your loved ones, and all your possessions!

May Yahweh make His FACE [TO BE ACCESSIBLE TO YOU]
