# THE PRAYER OF BLESSING-PT-9 (HEBREW WORD FOR "GIVE" AND "SHALOM") Sunday, October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Pastor Audie Clairmont

The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, and *give* you *peace.* — **NUMBERS 6:26** 

Siym (sem) – give - "to put, place, set" - "to cause it to be established"

Shalom - "completeness, wholeness.

### Colossians 2:10-Passion

And our own <u>completeness is now found in him.</u> We are completely filled with God as Christ's fullness overflows within us.

shalam, which means "to make <u>amends</u>" (return, payback, recompense)

**Shalom** is "to make <u>restitution</u>." "to restore something and make it even better than its former or original state."

## Joel 2:25-GNB

I will give you back what you lost in the years when swarms of locusts ate your crops.

Shalom - "vigor and vitality" in all dimensions of life.

shalom speaks of holistic ("holy") health for our souls and spirits.

## **JEREMIAH 29:11**

For I know the plans that I have for you, says [YHWH], plans for <u>peace</u> and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

# **REVELATION 21:4, NKJV**

And [God] will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.

## **ROMANS 15:13**

Now may the [God] of hope [YHWH] fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Spirit [Ruach HaKodesh].

## **PSALM 122:6 KJV**

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

"Shabbat shalom," he is saying after a long week of working and feeling drained and tired, "May the God of Israel restore you this Sabbath and bring about wholeness and completeness for you."

Shalom means - completeness, wholeness, health, peace, welfare, safety, soundness, tranquility, prosperity, perfectness, fullness, rest, harmony, the absence of agitation or discord.

Shalom - to be complete, perfect and full.

Shelem means "to pay for," and Shulam means "to be fully paid."

The amplified Hebrew-to-English translation of this portion is: May YHWH (YeHoVaH, YaHWeH, your heavenly Father) set in place all you need to be whole and complete so you can walk in victory, moment by moment, by the power of the Holy Spirit. May He give you supernatural health, peace, welfare, safety, soundness, tranquility, prosperity, perfection, fullness, rest, and harmony, as well as the absence of agitation and discord.
