

Jos 1:1 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying:

Jos 1:2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel.

Courage isn't the absence of fear, but Courage is going on in spite of fear.

1. Face your issues knowing that God has a call on your life. - 1:1-4.

"Joshua" *Y'hoshua* - means "*God saves*" and is the Hebrew form of "Jesus" *Yeshua*

Hebrews 6:12-NKJV

12 that you do not become sluggish, but...imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Ephesians 4:1,7-NLT

1 Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God.

7 However, He has given each one of us a special gift through the generosity of Christ.

Message - ...Out of the generosity of Christ, each of us is given his own gift.

A. It is a call to servicing. - 1:1

Colossians 1:7-NLT

You learned about the Good News from Epaphras, our beloved co-worker. He is Christ's faithful servant, and he is helping us on your behalf.

B. It is a call to a detailed assignment - 1:2-4.

Jos 1:2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel.

Jos 1:3 Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses.

Jos 1:4 From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory.

2Timothy 3:17-Passion

Then you will be God's servant, fully mature and perfectly prepared to fulfill any assignment God gives you.

2. Face your issues with God's encouragement - 1:5-6.

Jos 1:5 No man shall *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you.

Jos 1:6 Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Colossians 2:7-Passion

Your spiritual roots go deeply into his life as you are continually infused with strength, encouraged in every way.

A. God encourages you with His presence - 1:5,9. He says, "*I will be with you*".

B. God encourages you with His promise - 1:5b. "*I will not leave you nor forsake you.*"

3. Face your issues with God's enablement - 1:7-9.

Jos 1:7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

Jos 1:8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Jos 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go."

Hebrews 13:21-AMP

Strengthen (complete, perfect) and make you what you ought to be and equip you with everything good that you may carry out His will; [while He Himself works in you] and accomplishes that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ (the Messiah); to Whom be the glory forever and ever (to the ages of the ages). Amen (so be it).

Passion - may he work perfection into every part of you giving you all that you need to fulfill your destiny.

There are two essentials one must adhere to concerning the Bible in order to be successful.

A. Scripture Meditation - 1:8.

B. Scriptural Application - 1:8.
