# 1Samuel 30:1-5-NLT

- ... Three days later, when David and his men arrived home at their town of Ziklag, they found that the Amalekites had made a raid into the Negev and Ziklag; they had crushed Ziklag and burned it to the ground.
- 2 They had carried off the women and children and everyone else but without killing anyone.
- 3 When David and his men saw the ruins and realized what had happened to their families,
- 4 they wept until they could weep no more.
- 5 David's two wives, Ahinoam from Jezreel and Abigail, the widow of Nabal from Carmel, were among those captured.
- And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

# 1. THE ENEMY WILL ATTACK YOUR FAMILY TO GET TO YOU.

# 1Peter 5:8 -CEV

**<u>Be on your quard</u>** and **<u>stay awake</u>**. Your enemy, the devil, is like a roaring lion, sneaking around to find **someone to attack.** 

# 1Peter 5:9-NLT

... <u>Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith</u>. Remember that your Christian brothers and sisters all over the world are going through the same kind of suffering you are.

Passion - Take a <u>decisive stand</u> against him and <u>resist his every attack</u> with strong, vigorous faith...

# 2. WE HAVE TO LEARN TO DEPEND ON GOD, NOT PEOPLE!

# 1Samuel 30:6-CJB

7 And David was <u>greatly distressed</u>; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: **but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.** 

**DISTRESSED** - Suffering great emotional pain, severely afflicted; harassed; oppressed with calamity or misfortune, to be boxed in.

# Proverbs 3:5-6-NLT

Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

8 Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take.

**Message** - Trust GOD from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for GOD's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track.

# James 4:7-8-CJB

- ... Therefore, <u>submit to God.</u> Moreover, take a stand against the Adversary, and he will flee from you.
- 8 Come close to God, and he will come close to you...

### 1Samuel 30:7-NLT

... Then he said to Abiathar the priest, "Bring me the ephod!" So Abiathar brought it.

# 3. LEARN TO TALK THE PROMISES OF GOD TO YOURSELF.

### Hebrews 10:23-AMP.

... So let us <u>seize and hold fast and retain</u> <u>without wavering the hope we cherish and confess and our acknowledgement of it, for He Who promised is reliable (sure) and faithful to His word.</u>

# 1Samuel 30:6-CJB

... But David strengthened himself in Adonai his God.

**Amplified Bible:** .... But David <u>encouraged and strengthened</u> himself in the Lord his God.

**Encouraged** – to be firm, or grow firm, be revived, be refreshed.

# 2Samuel 16:12-14-Message

- **11** My own son is trying to kill me, and this Benjaminite is merely cursing me. Leave him alone, for no doubt the Lord has told him to do it.
- 12 And who knows, maybe GOD will see the trouble I'm in today and exchange the curses for something good.
- 13 David and his men went on down the road, while Shimei followed along on the ridge of the hill alongside, cursing, throwing stones down on them, and kicking up dirt.
- 14 By the time they reached the Jordan River, *David and all the men of the company were exhausted.* There they rested and were revived.

# Acts 3:19-Passion

And now <u>you must repent and turn back to God</u> so that your sins will be removed, and <u>so that times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence</u>.

### Proverbs 15:4-AMP.

... A gentle tongue [with its healing power] is a tree of life, but willful contrariness in it breaks down the spirit.

**Passion** – 4 When you speak healing words, you offer others fruit from the tree of life. But unhealthy, negative words do nothing but crush their hopes.

# Romans 10:8-CJB

What, then, does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart." — that is, the word about trust which we proclaim, ...

# GOD'S PLAN FOR YOU IS TOTAL RECOVERY.

# 1Samuel 30:8-AMP.

... And David inquired of the Lord, saying, Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them? The Lord answered him, *Pursue*, for you shall surely *overtake them* and without fail *recover all*.

**Pursue:** follow or chase (someone or something): means to **go after it.** 

# Joshua 10:19-ESV

... but <u>do not stay there</u> yourselves. <u>Pursue your enemies; attack</u> their rear guard.

Do not let them enter their cities, for <u>the LORD your God has given them into your hand.</u>"

Overtake - means to: come upon, hit, strike, overwhelm, Overcome - means: pull ahead of, leave behind, outdistance, outstrip.

# John 16:33-AMP

... I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace and confidence. In the world you have tribulation and trials and distress and frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.]

**Recover:** find or regain possession of (something stolen or lost); save, rescue, retrieve.

# Psalm 22:8-NLT

... "Is this the one *who relies on the LORD?* Then let the *LORD save him!* If the LORD loves him so much, *let the LORD rescue him!*"

# 2Peter 2:9-AMP

... Now if [all these things are true, then be sure] the Lord knows how to rescue the godly out of temptations and trials,...
