James 5:16-17-Passion

Elijah was a man with human frailties, just like all of us, but *he prayed and received supernatural answers*. He actually shut the heavens over the land so there would be no rain for three and a half years!

1Kings 17:2- TLV

Then the word of Adonai came to him saying...

Elijah's *êlîyâh* (*ay-lee-yaw*) 'name means <u>"Yahweh is my</u> <u>God,"</u>

In 1Kings 17:1-Living Bible

Then Elijah, the prophet from Tishbe in Gilead, told King Ahab, "As surely as the Lord God of Israel lives—the God whom I worship and serve—there won't be any dew or rain for several years <u>until I say the word!"</u>

Ahab realized that only Elijah could bring back the rain! 1Kings 17:2-6-TLV

2 Then the word of Adonai came to him saying:

3 "Leave this place, turn eastward, and hide yourself by the *Wadi Cherith(ker-eeth)*, east of the Jordan.

4 *It will come about that you will drink from the wadi.* I have also commanded the ravens to feed you there."

5 So he went and did according to the word of Adonai—he went and lived by the Wadi Cherith, which is east of the Jordan.

6 The ravens kept bringing him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he drank from the *wadi*.

CJB - You are to drink from the stream...

DRB - And it shall be, you shall drink of the torrent;...

streams – *arabic-wadi-*found mainly in the Middle East. It's a riverbed, which is dry most of the year.

Cherith (ker-eeth)-to cut, cut a covenant.

Psalm 126:4-TLV

Restore us from captivity, Adonai, like streams in the Negev.

Passion - Now, Lord, do it again! <u>Restore us to our former</u> <u>glory!</u> May streams of your <u>refreshing flow over us until our</u> <u>dry hearts are drenched again.</u>

Solitude or getting alone means to <u>disappear</u> into God, to be immersed in <u>His peace</u>, to be lost in the <u>presence</u> of His Face.
