## BORN AGAIN TO A LIVING HOPE. Sunday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Audie Clairmont

Read: Peter 1:3-9

## Ephesians 2:12-Passion

...you were without the covenants and prophetic promises of the Messiah, *the promised hope*, and without God.

1. Our born-again experience brings us a living hope and lasting hope.

**Verse 3** - we are <u>reborn</u> to experience a *living*, <u>energetic hope</u> through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

**Hope** – an anticipation (expectation) with pleasure, confidence, trust... "to expect with desire."

We are expectantly, patiently waiting for God to do what He says He will do.

Expectant hope "is closely linked with 'faith and trust' and results in 'patient waiting." True faith results in Hope.

NKJV...Now faith is the substance of *things hoped for*, (Heb. 11:1)

**GW - ...** Faith assures us of things we expect...

Williams - ...Now faith is the *assurance* of the things <u>we hope for</u>,

Passion - ...Now faith <u>brings our hopes into reality</u> and <u>becomes the</u>

<u>foundation</u> needed to acquire the things <u>we long for</u>.

## 1Timothy 1:1

From Paul, an apostle in Christ Jesus, for it was *Jesus himself, our living hope*, who sent me as his servant by the command of God, our life-giver.

2. Our born-again experience brings us hope of an <u>eternal inheritance</u>.

**Verse** – 4 We are reborn into a *perfect inheritance* that can never perish, never be defiled, and never diminish. It is promised and preserved forever in the heavenly realm for you!

3. Our born-again experience will bring us hope for our <u>complete</u> deliverance when Jesus returns.

5 Through our faith, the mighty power of God <u>constantly guards us</u> until our <u>full salvation</u> is ready to be revealed in the last time.

4. It's our hope in Christ Jesus that <u>keeps us going through</u> the difficulties of life.

## Psalm 119:81-GW

My soul is weak from waiting for you to save me. <u>My hope is based on your word.</u>

We know until Christ returns, that the believer will go through testing.

6 May the thought of this cause you to <u>jump for joy</u>, <u>even though lately</u> <u>you've had to put up with the grief of many trials.</u>

7 But these only <u>reveal the sterling core</u> of your faith, which is far more valuable than gold that perishes, for even gold is refined by fire. **Your authentic faith** will result in even more praise, glory, and honor when Jesus the Anointed One is revealed.

In verse 6 – Peter is talking about the believers suffering difficulties and persecutions.

**Amplified bible -** though now <u>for a little while</u> you may be distressed by trials and suffer temptations,...

**NKJB** - <u>though now for a little while, **if need be**</u>, you have been *grieved by various trials*,...

**Living Bible** - So be truly glad! There is wonderful joy ahead, <u>even though</u> the going is <u>rough for a while down here</u>.

In verse 7 – Peter compares the trial of our faith to the testing of gold. The word "trial" means "approval."

Verse 8-9- You love him passionately <u>although you did not see him, but</u> <u>through believing in him</u> you are saturated with an ecstatic joy, indescribably sublime and immersed in glory.

9 For *you are reaping the harvest of your faith*—the *full salvation promised you*—your souls' victory!
