WE HAVE RESURRECTION POWER! April 4th, 2021 Pastor Audie Clairmont

Philippians 3:10-(NKJV)

...that I may know Him and the <u>power of His resurrection</u>, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death...

Passion - And I continually long to know the wonders of Jesus more fully and to <u>experience the overflowing power of his resurrection</u> <u>working in me.</u> I will be one with him in his sufferings and I will be one with him in his death.

1. The resurrection of Jesus has the power to convert/change us.

Romans 3:23(NKJV)

...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. **Passion** - for we all have sinned and are in need of the glory of God.

1 John 1:8(NKJV)

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

Ephesians 2:5-6-Passion

Even when we were dead and doomed in our many sins, <u>he united us into the very life of Christ and saved us by his wonderful grace!</u>

He raised us up with Christ the exalted One, <u>and we ascended with him into the glorious perfection and authority</u> of the heavenly realm, for we are now co-seated as one with Christ!

2. The resurrection of Jesus gives us the power to Conquer/Overcome.

Romans 8:37(NKJV)

Yet in all these things <u>we are more than conquerors through Him</u> <u>who loved us.</u>

Ephesians 1:19-20-Passion

I pray that you will continually experience the immeasurable greatness of God's power made available to you through faith. Then your lives will be an advertisement of <u>this immense power as it works</u> <u>through you!</u> This is the mighty power that was released when God raised Christ from the dead and exalted him to the place of highest honor and supreme authority in the heavenly realm!

3. The resurrection of Jesus has the power to conform/mold us.

Romans 12:1-Passion

Beloved friends, what should be our proper response to God's marvelous mercies? I encourage you to <u>surrender yourselves to God</u> to be his sacred, living sacrifices. And live in holiness, experiencing all <u>that delights his heart.</u> For this becomes your genuine expression of worship.

Philippians 1:6(NKJV)

...being confident of this very thing, <u>that He who has begun a good</u> <u>work in you will complete it</u> until the day of Jesus Christ;

4. The resurrection power of Jesus confirms/backs up the truth.

Mark 16:20-GW

The disciples spread the Good News everywhere. The Lord worked with them. *He <u>confirmed his word</u> by the miraculous signs that accompanied it.*

1 Corinthians 15:42-44-Passion

And that's how it will be with the resurrection of the dead.
The body is "sown" in decay but will be raised in immortality. It is "sown" in humiliation but will be raised in glorification.
It is "sown" in weakness but will be raised in power. If there is a physical body, there is also a spiritual body.
