MOUNTAIN MOVING FAITH. Sunday, July 4th, 2021 Pastor Audie D. Clairmont

Mark 11:23-24-NKJV

- 23 For assuredly, I say to you, <u>whoever says</u> to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things <u>he says</u> will be done, he will have whatever <u>he says</u>.
- 24 Therefore I say to you, *whatever things <u>you ask</u> when you pray*, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.

Passion Bible - 22Jesus replied, "Let the faith of God be in you! 23Listen to the truth I speak to you: If someone says to this mountain with great faith and having no doubt, 'Mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the midst of the sea,' and believes that what he says will happen, it will be done. 24This is the reason I urge you to boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer—be that you have received it and it will be yours.

1. JESUS CAME TO RETURN TO US OUR AUTHORITY IN THE EARTH.

Luke 9:1-2-AMP.

- 1 THEN JESUS called together the Twelve [apostles] and <u>gave them power and</u> authority over all demons, and to cure diseases,
- 2 And He sent them out **to announce and preach the kingdom of God** and **to bring healing**.

1John 3:8-AMP

8 ...The reason the Son of God was made manifest (visible) was to <u>undo (destroy,</u> loosen, and dissolve) the works the devil [has done].

Matthew 6:10-CIB

- 6 May your Kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven.
- 2. MOVING MOUNTAINS IN OUR LIVES COMES WITH <u>DECREEING</u> AND <u>DECLARING</u> THE PROMISES OF GOD.

Decree - an official order issued by a legal authority. Command, proclamation.

Job 22:28-AMP

28 You shall also decide and <u>decree a thing</u>, and <u>it shall be established for you;</u> and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways.

Isaiah 42:9-AMP.

9 Behold, the former things have come to pass, and <u>new things I now declare; before</u> <u>they spring forth I tell you of them.</u>

Romans 4:17-NIRV

...The God that Abraham believed in gives life to the dead. Abraham's God also <u>speaks</u> of things that do not exist as if they do exist.

Romans 10:8-the Scriptures

But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" – that is, the word of belief which we are proclaiming: ...

Psalm 34:17-19-AMP.

- When the righteous cry for help, <u>the Lord hears, and delivers them out of all their</u> distress and troubles.
- 18 The Lord is close to those who are of a broken heart and saves such as are crushed with sorrow for sin and are humbly and thoroughly penitent.
- 19 Many evils confront the [consistently] righteous, <u>but the Lord delivers him out of them all.</u>

Psalm 91:1,7-AMP.

<u>HE WHO dwells in the secret place</u> of the Most High <u>shall remain stable and fixed under</u> <u>the shadow of the Almighty</u> [Whose power no foe can withstand].

7 A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, <u>but it shall not come near you.</u>

Hebrews 4:14-AMP.

14 Inasmuch then as we have a great High Priest Who has [already] ascended and passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, <u>let us hold fast our confession [of faith in Him].</u>

Hebrews 10:23-GW

23 We must continue to hold firmly to our declaration of faith. The one who made the promise is faithful.

FAITH DECLARATIONS
