We need God's supernatural love.

John 13:34-Passion

34 "So I give you now a new commandment: Love each other just as much as I have loved you.

35 For when you demonstrate the same love I have for you by loving one another, everyone will know that you're my true followers."

1John 4:7-12-Passion

7 Those who are loved by God, let his love continually pour from you to one another, because God is love. Everyone who loves is fathered by God and experiences an intimate knowledge of him.

1Jn 4:8 The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for God is love.

1Jn 4:9 The light of God's love shined within us when he sent his matchless Son into the world so that we might live through him.

1Jn 4:10 This is love: He loved us *long before we loved him*. It was his love, not ours. He proved it by sending his Son to be the pleasing sacrificial offering to take away our sins.

1Jn 4:11 Delightfully loved ones, if he loved us with such tremendous love, then "loving one another" should be our way of life!

1Jn 4:12 No one has ever gazed upon the fullness of God's splendor. But if we love one another, God makes his permanent home in us, and we make our permanent home in him, and his love is brought to its full expression in us.

Romans 12:9-10-Passion

Let the inner movement of your heart always be to love one another, and never play the role of an actor wearing a mask. Despise evil and embrace everything that is good and virtuous.

Be devoted to tenderly loving your fellow believers as members of one family. Try to outdo yourselves in respect and honor of one another.

1Peter 4:8-AMP

Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and disregards the offenses of others]. [Pro 10:12]

Proverbs 10:12 -Passion

12 Hatred keeps old quarrels alive, but love draws a veil over every insult and finds a way to make sin disappear.

KJV - And *above all things* have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.

have (echo) fervent charity— *echo- can also mean "to maintain," "to possess," "to keep," or "to be so closely joined to something that you become its echo."*

The word "*fervent*" here means "stretched out." *Christian love (agape) never reaches a breaking point!*

1 Corinthians 13:7-Passion

Love is a safe place of shelter, for it never stops believing the best for others.

Bears/beareth - *stego* is actually the word for "roof" - to cover with silence (*endure* patiently).
