## 1 Corinthians 12:12-Passion

Just as the human body is one, though it has many parts that together form one body, so too is Christ.

# Act 2:44-Passion All the believers were in <u>fellowship as one body</u>, and they <u>shared with</u> <u>one another whatever they had</u>.

Act 2:45 *Out of generosity* they even sold their assets to distribute the proceeds to those who were in need among them.

Act 2:46 <u>Daily they met together in the temple courts</u> and <u>in one another's homes to</u>

*celebrate communion.* They shared meals together with joyful hearts and tender humility.

Act 2:47 They were continually filled with praises to God, *enjoying the favor of all the people*. And the Lord kept adding to their number daily those who were coming to life.

### Philippians 2:3-Passion

**3** Be free from pride-filled opinions, *for they will only harm your <u>cherished unity</u>.* Don't allow self-promotion to hide in your hearts, but in authentic humility *put others first* and *view others as more important than yourselves*.

4 Abandon every display of selfishness. Possess a greater concern for what matters to others instead of your own interests.

1Cor 12:14...the human body is not one single part, but rather many parts mingled into one.

### All of us committing as one.

#### Ephesians 4:16 Passion

For his "body" has been formed in his image and is <u>closely joined together and</u> <u>constantly connected as one.</u> And <u>every member has been given divine gifts to</u> <u>contribute to the growth of all;</u> and <u>as these gifts operate effectively throughout the</u> <u>whole body</u>, we are <u>built up and made perfect in love</u>.

**1Cor 12:15** So if the foot were to say, "Since I'm not a hand, I'm not a part of the body," it's forgetting that it is still a vital part of the body.

**1Cor 12:16** And if the ear were to say, "Since I'm not an eye, I'm not really a part of the body," it's forgetting that it is still an important part of the body.

**1Cor 12:17** Think of it this way. If the whole body were just an eyeball, how could it hear sounds? And if the whole body were just an ear, how could it smell different fragrances?

**1Cor 12:18** But God has carefully *designed each member* and placed it in the body to function *as he desires.* 

**1Cor 12:19** <u>*A diversity is required*</u>, for if the body consisted of one single part, there wouldn't be a body at all!

**1Cor 12:20** So now we see that there are <u>many differing parts and functions</u>, but one body.

**1Cor 12:27** You are the body of the Anointed One, and *each of you is a unique and vital part of it.* 

Rom 12:4-Passion In the human body there are *many parts and organs, <u>each with a</u> <u>unique function.</u>* 

Rom 12:5 And so it is in the body of Christ. For though we are many, we've all been mingled into one body in Christ. This means *that we are all vitally joined to one another, with <u>each contributing to the others.</u>* 

Rom 12:6 God's marvelous grace *imparts to each one of us varying gifts and ministries* that are uniquely ours.

Let me challenge your commitment level to the church.

1. If your committed to a church, don't participate in <u>negative talk</u> about the people or the ministries.

2. If your committed to a church, Start taking time to <u>get involved</u> with the ministry and the people – offer your services.

3. If your committed to a church, start supporting it with your <u>finances</u>.

4. If your committed to a church, start supporting it with your time.

5. If your committed to a church, <u>come expecting</u>.

6. If your committed to a church, find out what part of the body you are – what you should be doing within the Church.

7. If your committed to a church, <u>encourage</u> somebody.

8. If your committed to a church, <u>help someone</u>.

9. If your committed to a church, <u>care for it</u>.

10. If your committed to a church, go out and bring others in.
