Stop Wrestling and Start Resting. Sunday, November 7th, 2021 Audie Clairmont

Hebrews 4:9-10-KJV

There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God. For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his.

Passion - 9 So we conclude that <u>there is still a full and complete "rest"</u> waiting for believers to experience.

10 As we enter into God's <u>faith-rest life</u> <u>we cease from our own</u> <u>works</u>, just as God <u>celebrates</u> his finished works and rests in them.

"rest" - sabbatismos, (sab-bat-is-mos') - refers to the Sabbath day.

Genesis 2:2-3-KJV

"And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. And God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made."

Therefore, the Sabbath was a day of <u>unbroken rest and pause from</u> work.

Our true Sabbath rest is found in the <u>finished work of Christ</u> (Matt. 11:28–30; Col. 2:16–17; Heb. 3:17–4:9; Rev. 21:25).

"entered" is the Greek word **eiserchomai**. (*ice-er'-khom-ahee*)-entering into <u>that specific location</u>.

"cease" - Gk. katapauo (kat-ap-ow'-o) — gives the idea of someone who has worked hard, but now has <u>sat down</u>, <u>settled down</u>, and has ceased from his labor.
