

## SEEING EVERY SITUATION FROM GOD'S VIEWPOINT.

### 2Corinthians 4:17-18-CJB

For our **light** and **transient** troubles are achieving for us an everlasting **glory** whose **weight** is beyond description.

18 We **concentrate not on** what **is seen** but on what **is not seen**, since things seen are **temporary**, but things not seen are **eternal**.

NLT-17-18 ... For our **present troubles** are **small and won't last very long**. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!  
So we **don't look at the troubles we can see now**; rather, **we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen**. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

Passion - ... because we don't focus our attention on what is seen but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but the unseen realm is eternal.

- The Hebrew word for "glory" "kavod," has the root meaning,... "kaved"... "weighty" "To be heavy."

### Romans 8:17-18-AMP.

... And if we are [His] children, then we are [His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His inheritance with Him]; only we must share His suffering if we are to share His glory.

18 [But what of that?] For I consider that the sufferings of this present time (this present life) are not worth *being compared with the glory that is about to be revealed to us* and *in us* and *for us* and *conferred on us!*

KJV-Verse 18...While **we look not at** the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: **for the things which are seen are temporal**...

### 1. EVERY PROBLEM WE FACE HAS A SOLUTION THROUGH THE POWER OF GOD.

#### 2Corinthians 12:9-AMP

... But He said to me, My grace (My favor and loving-kindness and mercy) is enough for you [sufficient against any danger and **enables you to bear the trouble manfully**]; for My **strength and power** are made perfect (fulfilled and completed) and **show themselves** most effective in [your] weakness. Therefore, I will all the more gladly glory in my weaknesses and infirmities, that the **strength and power of Christ (the Messiah) may rest (yes, may pitch a tent over and dwell) upon me!**

**Temporal**: *brief, short-lived, momentary, fleeting, passing; endure for a time, for a season; temporal can also mean: subject to change.*

#### Colossians 3:2 –AMP.

... And **set your minds and keep them set on** what **is above (the higher things)**, not on the **things that are on the earth**.

### 2. YOU CAN CHANGE YOUR LIFE FROM FAILURE AND DEFEAT TO VICTORY AND SUCCESS.

#### Philippians 1:19-CJB

... for I know that **this will work out for my deliverance**, because of **your prayers** and **the support I get from the Spirit of Yeshua the Messiah**.

#### Romans 8:28-AMP.

... We are assured and know that [God being a partner in their labor] **all things work together and are [fitting into a plan] for good** to and for those who love God and are called according to [His] design and purpose.

### 3. GOD WANTS US TO LEARN HOW TO LIVE IN CONTINUOUS VICTORY, NOT IN DEFEAT!

#### 2Corinthians 2:14-AMP

... But thanks be to God, **Who in Christ always leads us in triumph** [as trophies of Christ's victory]

**The scripture bible** - ... But thanks be to Elohim who always leads us on, **to overcome in Messiah**....

#### 2Corinthians 4:8-9-AMP

... We are hedged in (pressed) on every side [troubled and oppressed in every way], **but not** cramped or crushed; we suffer embarrassments and are perplexed and unable to find a way out, **but not** driven to despair;

9 We are pursued (persecuted and hard driven), **but not** deserted [to stand alone]; we are struck down to the ground, **but never** struck out and destroyed;

II Corinthians 2:14-KJV-... "Now thanks be unto God, which **always causeth us to triumph** in Christ . . ."
