### JESUS CHRIST IS OUR FIRSTFRUITS.

**Leviticus 23:9-11** And the LORD spoke unto Moses saying:

- **10** Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them: When ye are come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring *the sheaf* of the *first-fruits of your harvest* unto the priest.
- 11 And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you; on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

*Firstfruits* is prophetic of the *resurrection of Jesus*.

**Firstfruit-** The <u>first portion</u> of something which has been set aside in dedication and offering to God. (Ne 12:44; Pr 3:9)

Firstfruit: It means: "A Promise To Come".

Jesus was <u>"The Promised Seed"</u>

**Galatians 3:19(NIV)** 19 What, then, was the purpose of the law? It was added because of transgressions *until the Seed to whom the promise referred had come...* 

Jesus was <u>"set apart"</u> as an offering to God.

Luke 2:23, 28 – The scriptures- as it has been written in the Torah of Yahweh, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called <u>set-apart to God (Yaweh)" –</u> 28 then <u>he took Him up in his arms</u> and blessed Elohim and said,...

Jesus is the *First-begotten* of our Heavenly Father.

## Hebrews 1:6(KJV)

6 And again, when *he bringeth in the <u>first-begotten</u> into the world*, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.

Jesus is called the Firstfruits of those who rise from the dead.

- **1 Corinthians 15:20-23(NKJ)** 20 But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the **firstfruits** of those who have fallen asleep.
- For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
- For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.

But each one in his own <u>order</u>: <u>Christ the firstfruits</u>, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming.

We are <u>HIS</u> Firstfruits.

James 1:18(NKJ) 18 Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of His creatures.

## John 12:24(NAS)

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless *a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies*, it remains by itself alone; but *if it dies, it bears much fruit.* 

Firstfruits is also a remembrance in one's heart that God had redeemed them out of slavery into a new kingdom.

**Romans 8:11-GNB**- If the Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from death, <u>lives in you</u>, then he who raised Christ from death will also <u>give life to your mortal bodies</u> by the presence of his Spirit in you.

Romans 6:4-GNB- By our baptism, then, we were buried with him and shared his death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from death by the <u>glorious power</u> of the Father, so also we might live a new life.

#### WHAT CAN JESUS SET ME FREE FROM?

## 1. FROM THE PAIN OF YESTERDAY

**Isaiah 43:18-19 (NCV)** "The Lord says, 'Forget about what has happened before. Do not think about the past. Instead, **look at the new thing I am going to do.'**"

Psalm 34:18 (NCV) "The Lord is <u>close to the brokenhearted</u> and <u>He saves those</u> whose spirits have been crushed."

Romans 3:23-24 (TLB) "All of us have sinned... yet God declares us 'not guilty' if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in His mercy freely takes away our sins."

## 2. FROM THE PRESSURES OF TODAY

You need *strength* and you need *stability*.

**Isaiah 40:28-29 (NLT)** "God never grows faint or weary... He gives power to those who are tired and worn out."

Philippians 4:13 (Ph) "I'm ready for anything through the strength of Christ who lives in me."

Matthew 11:28-29 (Mes) Jesus: "Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to Me for real rest... and you'll recover your life... and you'll learn to live... freely and lightly."

### 3. FROM PESSIMISM ABOUT TOMORROW

There are two reasons why people lose hope.

- 1. When you're facing a situation that needs to be changed and <u>you can't</u> change it.
- 2. When you don't know the purpose that God made you for.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NCV) "I know what I am planning for you," says the Lord, "I have good plans for you, not plans to hurt you. I will give you hope and a good future."

Psalm 125:1 (TLB) "Those who trust in the Lord <u>are as steady</u> as Mount Zion, unmoved by any circumstance."

**Isaiah 54:10 (GN)** "The mountains and hills may crumble but <u>My love for you will</u> never end, so says the Lord who loves you."
