## Colossians 4:2-6-NIV

- 2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.
- 3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.
- 4 Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.
- 5 Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity.
- 6 Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

## 'Devote yourselves to prayer'

**Passion** - Be faithful to pray as intercessors...

The word **devote or (continue-KJV)** Paul uses is 'proskartereō - pros-kar-ter-eh'-o - which means to attend to something constantly.

The idea of *praying without ceasing,* has to do of *practicing the presence of God*.

...being watchful and thankful...

Passion - who are fully alert and giving thanks to God.

**Watch** - give strict attention to, be cautious, active...

And pray for us, too, that God <u>may open a door</u> for our message, ... Passion - And please pray for me, that God will open a door of opportunity for us to preach the revelation of the mystery of Christ,

**Passion** - Pray that I would unfold and reveal fully this mystery, for that is my delightful assignment...

**Be wise** in the way you act toward <u>outsiders;</u> make the most of every opportunity.

**Passion** - Walk in the wisdom of God as you live before the unbelievers and make it your duty to make him known.

Passion - Let every word you speak be <u>drenched with grace and</u> <u>tempered with truth and clarity.</u> For then you will be prepared to give a respectful answer to anyone who asks about your faith.

The Greeks called **salt** - *halas* – *prudence* (using wisdom, being careful, using tact) - charis — grace — because <u>it gave flavor to things</u>.

Firstly, to...make the most of every <u>opportunity.</u>
Passion - *and make it your duty to make him known*.

Secondly, that our conversation 'be always <u>full of grace'</u>.

Passion - Let every word you speak be <u>drenched with grace...</u>

Thirdly, ...then we will know how to answer everyone.

Passion - For then you will be prepared to give a respectful answer to anyone who asks about your faith.

Proverbs 11: 2 says that 'with pride comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom'.
