1Samuel 1:10-20-NLT

- 10 Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the LORD.
- 11 And she made this vow: "O LORD of Heaven's Armies, if You will look upon my sorrow and answer my prayer and give me a son, then I will give him back to You. He will be Yours for his entire lifetime, and as a sign that he has been dedicated to the LORD, his hair will never be cut. [He will drink neither wine nor intoxicants.]"
- 12 As she was praying to the LORD, Eli watched her.
- 13 Seeing her lips moving but hearing no sound, he thought she had been drinking.
- 14 "Must you come here drunk?" he demanded. "Throw away your wine!"

15 I will answer your cry for help <u>every time you pray, And you will find and feel</u> <u>my presence Even in your time of pressure and trouble.</u> I will be your glorious Hero and give you a feast!

A. Hannah...prayed in the midst of her pain and sorrow.

1 Samuel 1:10

10 ... Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the LORD.

Proverbs 15:13-Passion

13 A cheerful heart puts a smile on your face, but <u>a broken heart leads to</u> depression.

B. Hannah prayed in secret between her and God.

Matthew 6:6-NKJV

6 But you, when you pray, <u>go into your room</u>, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father <u>who is in the secret place</u>; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

1 Samuel 1:12-13 - 12...As she was praying to the LORD, Eli watched her. 13 Seeing her lips moving but hearing no sound, he thought she had been drinking.

C. Hannah...prayed until her request was confirmed or answered.

1 Thessalonians 5:17-KJV

17 Pray without ceasing.

NLT - ... Never stop praying.

Example Jesus gave of a persistent prayer.

Luke 11:5-10-Passion

- 5 Then Jesus gave this illustration: "Imagine what would happen if you were to go to one of your friends in the middle of the night and pound on his door and shout, 'Please! Do you have some food you can spare?
- 6 A friend just arrived at my house unexpectedly and I have nothing to serve him.'
- 7 But your friend says, 'Why are you bothering me? The door's locked and my family and I are all in bed. Do you expect me to get up and give you our food?' 8 But listen— because of your shameless impudence, even though it's the middle of the night, your friend will get up out of his bed and give you all that you need.

- 9–10 So it is with your prayers. Ask and you'll receive. Seek and you'll discover. Knock on heaven's door, and it will one day open for you. Every persistent person will get what he asks for. Every persistent seeker will discover what he needs. And everyone who knocks persistently will one day find an open door.
- D. Hannah... prayed with faith and power.
- **1 Samuel 1:20**... and <u>in due time</u> she gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel, for she said, <u>"I asked the LORD for him."</u>

Samuel – she-mu-e l- "heard of God."

Colossians 4:2

2 Be earnest and unwearied and steadfast in your prayer [life], being [both] alert and intent in [your praying] with thanksgiving.

Passion - ...Be faithful to *pray as intercessors* who are fully alert and giving thanks to God.

- E. Hannah... kept her promise to the Lord.
