WHAT'S ON YOUR MIND? Sunday, July 16th, 2023 Audie Dean Clairmont

Philippians 4:8-AMP.

For the rest, brethren, whatever is *true*, whatever is *worthy of reverence* and is *honorable* and *seemly*, whatever is *just*, whatever is *pure*, whatever is *lovely* and *lovable*, whatever is *kind* and *winsome* and *gracious*, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, *think on and weigh and take account of these things [fix your minds on them].*

Passion – 8 So <u>keep your thoughts continually fixed</u> on all that is authentic and real, honorable and admirable, beautiful and respectful, pure and holy, merciful and kind. And *fasten your thoughts on every glorious work of God, praising him always*.

The object is not retreat in an evil world, but soundness of thought/mind in it.

1. WE MUST LEARN TO BRING OUR THOUGHTS CAPTIVE TO THE WORD OF GOD.

2Corinthians 10:4-5-AMP.

- **4** For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds,
- 5 [Inasmuch as we] refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that <u>sets itself up</u> against the [true] knowledge of God; and <u>we lead</u> every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One), ...
- **KJV-...**Casting down *imaginations*, and every *high thing (barriers)* that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, ...

Passion – 4 ...Instead, our spiritual weapons are energized with divine power <u>to</u> <u>effectively dismantle the defenses behind which people hide.</u> 5 We can <u>demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God</u> and <u>break through every arrogant attitude</u> that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. <u>We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought</u> and <u>insist that it bow in obedience</u> to the Anointed One.

2Corinthians 4:4-Passion

...for <u>their minds have been blinded by the god of this age, leaving them in unbelief</u>.

Their blindness keeps them <u>from seeing</u> the dayspring light of the wonderful news of the glory of Jesus Christ, who is the <u>divine</u> image of God.

2. WE MUST LEARN TO THINK GOD'S THOUGHTS ABOUT OUR LIVES.

Psalm 139:23-24-AMP

... Search me [thoroughly], O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts!

24 And see if there is any wicked *or* hurtful way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Passion - 23 God, <u>I invite your searching gaze into my heart. Examine me through and through; find out everything that may be hidden within me.</u> Put me to the test and sift through all my anxious cares.

24 <u>See if there is any path of pain I'm walking on, and lead me back</u> to your glorious, everlasting ways— the path that brings me back to you.

Isaiah 14:24-AMP

... The Lord of hosts has sworn, saying, Surely, <u>as I have thought and planned</u>, so shall it come to pass, and as I have purposed, so shall it stand--

Imagination - the faculty or action of forming new ideas, or images or concepts of external objects not present to the senses; It means creativity, vision.

3. WE DETERMINE OUR DESTINY WITH THE SEED THAT WE SOW.

Galatians 6:7-8-CJB

- 7 Don't delude yourselves: no one makes a fool of God! <u>A person reaps what he</u> sows.
- 8 Those who <u>keep sowing in the field of their old nature</u>, in order to meet its demands, <u>will eventually reap ruin</u>; but those who <u>keep sowing in the field of the Spirit will reap from the Spirit everlasting life.</u>

Mark 4:14-AMP

... The sower sows the Word.

Luke 6:45-NLT

... A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart. <u>What you say flows</u> <u>from what is in your heart.</u>

The good news is that you can dig up and replant.
