THE WAY TO VICTORY. Sunday, December17th, 2023 Audie Clairmont

Matthew 18:19-AMP

Again, I tell you, if <u>two</u> of you on earth <u>aaree (harmonize together, make a symphony</u> <u>together</u>) about whatever [anything and everything] they may ask, <u>it will come to pass and</u> <u>be done for them by My Father in heaven.</u>

Agreement – Heb. To "<u>perceive</u>" - ability to see beyond what is seen in the physical present together. Grk. - Having the "same mind".

The place of agreement is the place of <u>power</u>. The place of disagreement is the place of <u>powerlessness</u>.

Genesis 11:6 AMP.

"And the Lord said, Behold, they are <u>one people and they have all one language</u>; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them"

Jeremiah 23:29-KJV

"Is not *mv word* like as a fire? Saith the Lord; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?"

Luke 1:37-AMP

For with God nothing is ever impossible and <u>no word from God shall be without power or</u> <u>impossible of fulfillment.</u>

ASV. "For no word from God shall be void of power"

Passion - Not one promise from God is <u>empty of power</u>, for nothing is impossible with God!"

God's power is <u>released</u> to the <u>degree</u> that <u>obedience</u> is <u>exercised</u>.

Revelation 2:26-AMP

And <u>he who overcomes (is victorious) and who obeys My commands to the [very] end</u> [doing the works that please Me], I will give him authority and power over the nations; ... **Passion** - To everyone who is <u>victorious and continues to do my works to the very end</u> I will give you authority over the nations

God's promises are conditional.

James 1:25 TLB.

"But if anyone <u>keeps looking steadily into God's law</u> for free men, he will not only remember it, but <u>he will do what it says</u>, and God will greatly bless him in everything he does"

Psalm 86:11-AMP

Teach me Your way, O Lord, *that I may walk and live in Your truth; direct and <u>unite my</u> <u>heart</u> [solely, reverently] to fear and honor Your name.*

Unite my heart - means - being decided and firm in our commitment to that decision.

As you stand in agreement with <u>vourself</u>, with <u>God</u>, with <u>others</u>, and press through, you will <u>prevail</u>.

It is the *abiding between the crises* that gives us the strength *to endure each crisis*.

John 15:7-AMP

If you *live in Me* [*abide vitally united to Me*] and *My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts,* ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you.

1 Corinthians 3:1-3a

1 Brothers and sisters, when I was with you I found it impossible to speak to you as those who are spiritually mature people, for <u>you are still dominated by the mind-set of the flesh.</u> And because you are immature infants in Christ,

2 I had to nurse you and feed you with "milk," not with the solid food *of <u>more advanced</u> <u>teachinas</u>, because you weren't ready for it*. In fact, you are still not ready to be fed solid food,

3 for you are living your lives dominated by the mind-set of the flesh.

AMP - nonspiritual [men of the flesh, in whom the carnal nature rules you, controls.]

If we learn to abide in Christ, we learn to live from <u>"glory to glory"</u> instead of from <u>"crisis to crisis."</u> That's the Christlike life.

We need wisdom to live that life.

Proverbs 2:1-5

1 My son, if you will receive my words and treasure up my commandments within you,

2 Making your ear attentive to skillful and godly Wisdom and inclining and directing your

heart and mind to understanding [applying all your powers to the quest for it];

3 Yes, if you cry out for insight and raise your voice for understanding,

4 If you <u>seek [Wisdom] as for silver and search for skillful and godly Wisdom</u> as for hidden treasures,

5 Then you will understand the reverent and worshipful fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of [our omniscient] God.

Philippians 2:13 AMP.

"[<u>Not in your own strenath</u>] for it is God Who is <u>all the while effectually at work in you</u> [energizing and creating in you the <u>power and desire</u>], <u>both to will and to</u> work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight"

Faith lays hold of truth, and truth will always bring freedom.
