Matthew 18:19-AMP

Again, I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about whatever [anything and everything] they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Agreement – Heb. To “perceive” - ability to see beyond what is seen in the physical present together.

Grk. - Having the “same mind”.

The place of agreement is the place of power. The place of disagreement is the place of powerlessness.

Genesis 11:6 AMP.

“And the Lord said, Behold, they are one people and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them”

Jeremiah 23:29-KJV

“Is not my word like as a fire? Saith the Lord; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?”

Luke 1:37-AMP

For with God nothing is ever impossible and no word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfillment.

ASV. “For no word from God shall be void of power”

Passion - Not one promise from God is empty of power, for nothing is impossible with God!”

God’s power is released to the degree that obedience is exercised.

Revelation 2:26-AMP

And he who overcomes (is victorious) and who obeys My commands to the [very] end [doing the works that please Me], I will give him authority and power over the nations; ...

Passion - To everyone who is victorious and continues to do my works to the very end I will give you authority over the nations

God’s promises are conditional.

James 1:25 TLB.

“But if anyone keeps looking steadily into God’s law for free men, he will not only remember it, but he will do what it says, and God will greatly bless him in everything he does”

Psalms 86:11-AMP

Teach me Your way, O Lord, that I may walk and live in Your truth; direct and unite my heart [solely, reverently] to fear and honor Your name.

Unite my heart - means - being decided and firm in our commitment to that decision.

As you stand in agreement with yourself, with God, with others, and press through, you will prevail.

It is the abiding between the crises that gives us the strength to endure each crisis.

John 15:7-AMP

If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you.

1 Corinthians 3:1-3a

1 Brothers and sisters, when I was with you I found it impossible to speak to you as those who are spiritually mature people, for you are still dominated by the mind-set of the flesh. And because you are immature infants in Christ,

2 I had to nurse you and feed you with “milk,” not with the solid food of more advanced teachings, because you weren’t ready for it. In fact, you are still not ready to be fed solid food,

3 for you are living your lives dominated by the mind-set of the flesh.

AMP - nonspiritual [men of the flesh, in whom the carnal nature rules you, controls.]

If we learn to abide in Christ, we learn to live from “glory to glory” instead of from “crisis to crisis.” That’s the Christlike life.

We need wisdom to live that life.

Proverbs 2:1-5

1 My son, if you will receive my words and treasure up my commandments within you,

2 Making your ear attentive to skillful and godly Wisdom and inclining and directing your heart and mind to understanding [applying all your powers to the quest for it];

3 Yes, if you cry out for insight and raise your voice for understanding,

4 If you seek [Wisdom] as for silver and search for skillful and godly Wisdom as for hidden treasures,

5 Then you will understand the reverent and worshipful fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of [our omniscient] God.

Philippians 2:13 AMP.

“[Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight”
