RECEIVING GOD'S BEST FOR OUR LIVES. Sunday, March 24th, 2024 Pastor Audie D. Clairmont

1. IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE GOD'S BEST IN YOUR LIFE THEN - YOU MUST ACCEPT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF YOUR CHOICES.

Genesis 17:1-4-Lexham English Bible

- 1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old Yahweh appeared to Abram. And he said to him, "I am El-Shaddai; walk before me and be blameless
- 2 so that I may make my covenant between me and you and may multiply you exceedingly."
- 3 Then Abram fell upon his face and God spoke with him, saying,
- **4** "As for me, behold, my covenant shall be with you, and you shall be the father of a multitude of nations.

Gen. 15:7 And He said to him, "I am yahweh, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it."

Yahweh – Self- existent eternal one, He is present with HIS people, He is always near, intervening in history on behalf of his people. The knowledge of God's proper name implies **a covenant relationship**. The name yahweh brings forth images of God's saving power in the lives of his people.

El-shaddai-The God of plenty, the God of more than enough... creator and preserver of the world.

2. IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE GOD'S BEST IN YOUR LIFE - THEN YOU MUST ACCEPT THE FACT_THAT GOD HAS <u>ALREADY COMMITTED HIMSELF</u> TO, AND FOR YOU.

Verse 2 - ... so that <u>I may make my covenant between me and you</u> and may multiply you exceedingly."

Joshua 24:15-ESV

And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, <u>choose this day whom you will</u> <u>serve</u>, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But <u>as for me</u> and <u>my house</u>, we will serve the LORD."

Deuteronomy 30:19-20-CJB

19 "I call on heaven and earth to witness against you today that <u>I have presented</u> you with life and death, the blessing and the curse. Therefore, choose life, so that you will live, you and your descendants, ...

20 loving Adonai your God, <u>paying attention to what he says</u> and <u>clinging to him</u>for that is the purpose of your life! <u>On this depends</u> the length of time you will live in the land Adonai swore he would give to your ancestors Avraham, Yitz'chak and Ya`akov."

3. IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE GOD'S BEST IN YOUR LIFE - THEN YOU MUST <u>STAY</u> COMMITTED TO THE END.

Jeremiah 29:11-KJV

11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, *to give you an expected end.*

Romans 4:16-21-AMP.

Therefore, [inheriting] the promise is the outcome of faith and depends [entirely] on faith, in order that it might be given as an act of grace (unmerited favor), to make it stable and valid and guaranteed to all his descendants--not only to the devotees and adherents of the Law, but also to those who share the faith of Abraham, who is [thus] the father of us all.

- 17 As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. [He was appointed our father] in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed. [Gen. 17:5.]
- 18 [For Abraham, human reason for] hope being gone, hoped in faith that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been promised, So [numberless] shall your descendants be. [Gen. 15:5.]
- 19 He did not weaken in faith when he considered the [utter] impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or [when he considered] the barrenness of Sarah's [deadened] womb. [Gen. 17:17; 18:11.]
- 20 No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God,
- 21 Fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mighty to keep His word and to do what He had promised.

Psalm 84:11 - KJV

"For the Lord God is a sun and shield: The Lord will give grace and glory: **no good** thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly."

Gen. 17:1-AMP walk and live habitually before Me and be perfect (blameless, wholehearted, complete).
