Exodus 12:1-14-Tree of Life Version

Now Adonai spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying,

- 2 This month will mark the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year for you.
- 3 Tell all the congregation of Israel that on the tenth day of this month, each man is to take a lamb for his family one lamb for the household.
- 4 But if the household is too small for a lamb, then he and his nearest neighbor are to take one according to the number of the people.

According to each person eating, you are to make your count for the lamb.

- 5 Your lamb is to be without blemish, a year old male. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.
- **6** You must watch over it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to slaughter it at twilight.
- 7 They are to take the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the crossbeam of the houses where they will eat it.
- 8 They are to eat the meat that night, roasted over a fire. With matzot and bitter herbs they are to eat it.
- 9 Do not eat any of it raw or boiled with water, but only roasted with fire—its head with its legs and its innards.
- 10 So let nothing of it remain until the morning. Whatever remains until the morning you are to burn with fire.
- 11 Also you are to eat it this way: with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet and your staff in your hand. You are to eat it in haste. It is Adonai's Passover.
- 12 "For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night and strike down every firstborn, both men and animals, and I will execute judgments against all the gods of Egypt. I am Adonai.

- 13 The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. So there will be no plague among you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.
- 14 This day is to be a memorial for you. You are to keep it as a feast to Adonai. Throughout your generations you are to keep it as an eternal ordinance.

- 12:5 Your lamb is to be without blemish, ...

Matthew 27:24-NKJV

24 When Pilate saw that he could not prevail at all, but rather *that* a tumult was rising, he took water and washed *his* hands before the multitude, saying, "I am innocent of the blood of this just Person. You see to it."

1Corinthians 11:23-TLV

23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you—that the Lord Yeshua, on the night He was betrayed, *took matzah;*

1Corinthians 11:28-TLV

3. THE PASSOVER LAMB WILL BRING <u>SALVATION/HEALING</u> AND CLEANSING IF APPLIED TO OUR LIVES.

12:7-8-TLV

12:13 -TLV

The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are. When I see the blood, I will pass over you.

1Corinthians 11:24-26-TLV

- 24 ...and when He had given thanks, <u>He broke it</u> and said, "This is My body, which is for you. Do this in memory of Me."
- 25 In the same way, He also took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in memory of Me."
