1. YOU HAVE TO LET GO OF YOUR PAST ${\it IN ORDER}$ TO TAKE HOLD OF YOUR FUTURE.

Philippians 3:12-14-ERV

- I don't mean that I am exactly what God wants me to be. I have not yet reached that goal.

 But I continue trying to reach it and make it mine. That's what Christ Jesus wants me to do. It is the reason he made me his.
- 13 Brothers and sisters, I know that I still have a long way to go. <u>But there is one thing I</u> do: I forget what is in the past and try as hard as I can to reach the goal before me.
- 14 *I keep running hard toward the finish line* to get the prize that is mine *because God has called me through Christ Jesus* to life up there in heaven.

2. YOUR $\underline{\text{DESTINY}}$, YOUR $\underline{\text{FUTURE}}$, IS NOT A MATTER OF $\underline{\text{CHANCE}}$, BUT A MATTER OF $\underline{\text{CHOICE!}}$

Verse 12b... That's what Christ Jesus <u>wants me to do</u>. It is the reason he made me his.

Deuteronomy 30:19-NLT

"Today I have given you <u>the choice between life and death</u>, between <u>blessings and curses</u>. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness <u>the choice you make</u>. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!

Acts 20:24-Amplified

- ... <u>But none of these things move me</u>, neither do I esteem my life dear to myself, <u>if only I may finish my course with joy</u> and the ministry which I have obtained from [which was entrusted to me by] the Lord Jesus,...
- Acts 20:19- KJV-... Serving the Lord with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews:
- **Amplified...** Serving the Lord with all humility in tears and in the midst of adversity (affliction and trials) which befell me, due to the plots of the Jews [against me];
- 3. YOU HAVE TO <u>PROCLAIM YOUR FREEDOM</u> IN CHRIST JESUS *IN ORDER* TO LIVE OUT THAT FREEDOM IN CHRIST JESUS.

Isaiah 61:1-4-Amplified Bible

... THE SPIRIT of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed and

- qualified me to preach the Gospel of good tidings to the meek, the poor, and <u>afflicted;</u> He has <u>sent me to bind up and heal the brokenhearted</u>, to <u>proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives</u> and <u>the opening of the prison and of the eyes to those who are bound, [Rom. 10:15.]</u>
- 2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord [the year of His favor] and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, [Matt. 11:2-6; Luke 4:18, 19; 7:22.]
- 3 To grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion--to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, and failing spirit-that they may be called oaks of righteousness [lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.
- 4 <u>And they</u> shall <u>rebuild the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former desolations</u> and renew the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.
- **Verse 13**....I know that I still have a long way to go. <u>But there is one thing I do: I forget</u> what is in the past and try as hard as I can to reach the goal before me.

Isaiah 53:3-Amplified Bible

- He was despised and rejected and forsaken by men, a Man of sorrows and pains, and <u>acquainted with grief and sickness</u>, and like One from Whom men hide their faces <u>He was despised, and we did not appreciate His worth</u> or <u>have any esteem</u> for Him.
- 4 Surely <u>He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses)</u> and <u>carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment]</u>, yet <u>we [ignorantly] considered</u> <u>Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]. [Matt. 8:17.]</u>
- 5 But *He was wounded for our transgressions*, He <u>was bruised for our guilt and iniquities;</u> the <u>chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us was upon Him</u>, and <u>with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole.</u>
- 4. GOD IS NOT CONCERNED ABOUT YOUR <u>FAILINGS</u> OR <u>FALLINGS</u>, BUT HE IS CONCERNED ABOUT YOUR <u>RISING UPS</u> AND <u>RUNNING FORWARDS</u>.
- Verse 14...14 <u>I keep running hard</u> toward the finish line to get the prize that is mine <u>because God has called me through Christ Jesus</u> to life up there in heaven.
