

FEAST OF TRUMPETS
Rosh Hashanah-Yom Teruah
Return to God
Sunday, September 21st, 2025

Numbers 29:1 AMP

ON THE first day of the seventh month [*on New Year's Day of the civil year*], you shall have a holy [*summoned*] assembly; you shall do no servile work. ***It is a day of blowing of trumpets*** for you [*everyone blowing who wishes, proclaiming that the glad New Year has come and that the great Day of Atonement and the Feast of Tabernacles are now approaching*].

Yom Teruah means, "Day of Shouting/raising a noise."

Rosh Hashanah, means "head of the year."

It is a day to reflect on our special relationship with the God of the universe and recommit to walking in our created purpose

Teshuvah - means - to return to God/repentance A time of *self-examination, reconciliation, preparation.*

1. The First Step: to acknowledge and forsake your sin.

2Corinthians 13:5-AMP

Examine and test and evaluate your own selves to see whether you are holding to your faith and showing the proper fruits of it. Test and prove yourselves [*not Christ*]. Do you not yourselves realize and know [*thoroughly by an ever-increasing experience*] that Jesus Christ is in you--unless you are [*counterfeits*] disapproved on trial and rejected?

2. The second step of teshuvah is to regret your transgressions against God.

2Corinthians 7:10-RV

For **Godly sorrow worketh repentance unto salvation**, a repentance which bringeth no regret: ...

Psalm 51:17

...the sacrifices of God are a **broken spirit and a contrite heart.**

3. The third step is to confess our transgressions and make amends/restitution with those we've hurt.

James 5:16-AMP

Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and **pray [also] for one another**, that you may be healed and restored [*to a spiritual tone of mind and heart*].

Matthew 5:23-24-Passion

23 "So then, if you are presenting a gift before the altar in the temple and suddenly you remember a quarrel you have with a fellow believer, **24** leave your gift there in front of the altar and go at once to apologize with the one who is offended. Then, after you have reconciled, come to the altar and present your gift.

4. The fourth and final step is to accept God's forgiveness and move forward in faith.

Philippians 3:12-13-Passion

I admit that I haven't yet acquired the absolute fullness that I'm pursuing, but I run with passion *into his abundance* so that I may reach the purpose that Jesus Christ has called me to fulfill and wants me to discover.

13 I don't depend on my own strength to accomplish this; however, **I do have one compelling focus: I forget all of the past as I fasten my heart to the future instead.**

Aramaic - Elul - means to "search."

Feast of Trumpets/Rosh Hashanah/ Yom Teruah is the time of **being ready and getting ready** for when Jesus returns at the sound of a trumpet and brings His people home.

Mark 13:32-33-AMP

32 But of that day or that hour not a [*single*] person knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

33 Be on your guard [constantly alert], and watch and pray; for you do not know when the time will come.
