

### **Luke 18:1-AMP**

Also [Jesus] told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not to turn coward (faint, lose heart, and give up).

### **2Corinthians 4:15-18-Passion**

Yes, all things work for your enrichment so that more of God's marvelous grace will spread to more and more people, resulting in an even greater increase of praise to God, bringing him even more glory!

16 So no wonder we don't give up. For even though our outer person gradually wears out, our inner being is renewed every single day.

17 We view our slight, short-lived troubles in the light of eternity. We see our difficulties as the substance that produces for us an eternal, weighty glory far beyond all comparison,

18 because we don't focus our attention on what is seen but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but the unseen realm is eternal.

AMP – v-16 - Therefore we do not become discouraged (utterly spiritless, exhausted, and wearied out through fear).

### **Ephesians 3:12-13-KJV**

12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.

13 Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.

**boldness** – “the act of speaking”, - “to tell all”

### **Hebrews 4:14-16-RV**

14 Having then a great high priest, who hath passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

15 For we have not a high priest that cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but one that hath been in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

16 Let us therefore draw near with boldness unto the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy, and may find grace to help us in time of need.

### **Hebrews 10:19-RV**

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holy place by the blood of Jesus,...

### **James 4:10-NKJV**

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

**Access** - which means - "to a way of access"

**Ephesians 2:18-NKJV**

For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.

**Romans 5:1-2-NKJV**

1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,  
2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

**John 14:6-NKJV**

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

**Confidence** - gives the idea of "trust, confidence, total persuasion"

We are totally persuaded that we can come to the Father, trust Him to do His will, and be confident of the result.

**1John 5:14**

14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.  
15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

**Eph. 3:13** - "Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory."

**Faint** - "to be cowardly, to lose one's courage, to faint or despond in view of trial," "to be spiritless."

**Despondent:** in low spirits from loss of hope or courage...hopelessness.

**Proverbs 24:10**

"If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small."  
Passion - If you faint when under pressure, you have need of courage.

**2Thessalonians 2:16-17-Passion**

16 Now may the Lord Jesus Christ and our Father God, who loved us and in his wonderful grace gave us eternal comfort and a beautiful hope that cannot fail,  
17 encourage your hearts and inspire you with strength to always do and speak what is good and beautiful in his eyes.

**2Corinthians 3:5-Passion**

Yet we don't see ourselves as capable enough to do anything in our own strength, for our true competence flows from God's empowering presence.

**Romans 8:18**

"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us".
