

1. NO MATTER WHAT YOU MIGHT GO THROUGH...DON'T QUIT!

2. NO MATTER HOW IMPOSSIBLE YOUR SITUATION MAY SEEM...STAY ON COURSE.

3. WHEN YOUR PROBLEMS SEEM MORE THAN YOU CAN BARE...DEVELOP STAYING POWER.

4. WHEN IT SEEMS THAT NOTHING IS HAPPENING, REMEMBER THAT GOD IS ABOUT TO BRING IT ALTOGETHER FOR YOU.

James 5:10-11-AMP

10 [As] an example of suffering and ill-treatment together with patience, brethren, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord [as His messengers].

11 You know how we call those blessed (happy) who were steadfast [who endured]. You have heard of the endurance of Job, and you have seen the Lord's [purpose and how He richly blessed him in the] end, inasmuch as the Lord is full of pity and compassion and tenderness and mercy.

Message Bible - 10 Take the old prophets as your mentors. They put up with anything, went through everything, and never once quit, all the time honoring God.

11 What a gift life is to those who stay the course! You've heard, of course, of Job's staying power, and you know how God brought it all together for him at the end. That's because God cares, cares right down to the last detail.

Passion - ...yet they patiently endured. 11 We honor them as our heroes because they remained faithful even while enduring great sufferings.

KJV – Verse 11 - ...Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord...

Hebrews 6:12-TLV

12 so you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those inheriting the promises through trust and perseverance.

Living Bible - ...but you will be anxious to follow the example of those who receive all that God has promised them because of their strong faith and patience.

Ecclesiastes 7:8-AMP

8 Better is the end of a thing than the beginning of it, and the patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit.

Psalms 37:37-KJV

37 Mark the perfect *man*, and behold the upright: for the end of that man is peace.

TLV - Notice the man of integrity and watch the upright—for the man of shalom has a future.

AMP - ...for there is a happy end for the man of peace.

Passion - ... *The godly ones will have a peaceful, prosperous future with a happy ending.*

Psalms 37:39-40-AMP

39 But the salvation of the [consistently] righteous is of the Lord; He is their Refuge and secure Stronghold in the time of trouble.

40 And the Lord helps them and delivers them; He delivers them from the wicked and saves them, because they trust and take refuge in Him.

Deuteronomy 8:16-AMP

Who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and test you, to do you good in the end.

Jeremiah 29:11-KJV

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

Message Bible - ... I know what I'm doing. I have it all planned out--plans to take care of you, not abandon you, plans to give you the future you hope for.

Revised Version – to give you a hope in your latter end.

Jubilee Bible - to give you the end that you wait for.

2Corinthians 4:1-AMP

THEREFORE, SINCE we do hold and engage in this ministry by the mercy of God [granting us favor, benefits, opportunities, and especially salvation], we do not get discouraged (spiritless and despondent with fear) or become faint with weariness and exhaustion.

KJV - ...we faint not...

NLT - ...we never give up...

Message Bible - ...we're not about to throw up our hands and walk off the job just because we run into occasional hard times.

2Corinthians 4:8-AMP

We are hedged in (pressed) on every side [troubled and oppressed in every way], but not cramped or crushed; we suffer embarrassments and are perplexed and unable to find a way out, but not driven to despair...

Message Bible - ... *We've been surrounded and battered by troubles, but we're not demoralized...*

Living Bible - ... *We are perplexed because we don't know why things happen as they do, but we don't give up and quit.*

2Corinthians 4:17-NKJV

*For our **light affliction**, which **is but for a moment**, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory,...*

Message Bible - *These hard times are small potatoes compared to the coming good times, the lavish celebration prepared for us.*

Living Bible - ...These troubles and sufferings of ours are, after all, quite small and **won't last very long. Yet this short time of distress** will result in God's richest blessing upon us forever and ever!

2Corinthians 4:18-Living Bible

18 So we do not look at what we can see right now, the troubles all around us, but we look forward to the joys in heaven which we have not yet seen. The troubles will soon be over, but the joys to come will last forever.

Message Bible - ...*There's far more here than meets the eye. The things we see now are here today, gone tomorrow. But the things we can't see now will last forever.*

2Corinthians 5:7-NKJV

7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Message Bible - ...*It's what we trust in but don't yet see that keeps us going.*
